

issued to TEDDY GLYNN HICKMAN § ORDER

On this day the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Board, considered the matter of TEDDY GLYNN HICKMAN, Registered Nurse License Number 660440, hereinafter referred to as Respondent. This action was taken in accordance with Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code.

Respondent waived informal proceedings, notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Order.

The Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Prior to the institution of Agency proceedings, notice of the matters specified below in these Findings of Fact was provided to Respondent and Respondent was given an opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license(s).
- 2. Respondent waived informal proceedings, notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Order.
- 3. Respondent is currently licensed to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas.
- 4. Respondent received an Associate degree from Trinity Valley Community College, Kaufman, Texas, on May 1, 1999. Respondent was licensed to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas on June 15, 1999.



- 5. Respondent's complete professional nursing employment history is unknown.
- 6. On or about October 26, 2011, Respondent was arrested and indicted on two counts of "Indecency with a child sexual contact" (2nd Degree Felony offenses) committed on November 26, 2010, in Lubbock, Texas, under Cause # 2011-432,681. Respondent's conduct was likely to injure patients, in that a nurse may be required to treat minor children thereby placing the patients and public in potential danger.
- 7. In response to Finding of Fact Number Six (6), Respondent explicitly denies the allegations.
- Formal Charges were filed and mailed to Respondent on or about January 18, 2012. First Amended Formal Charges were filed and mailed to the Respondent on or about June 26, 2012.
- 9. Respondent, by his signature to this Order, expresses his desire to voluntarily surrender his license(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451-301.555, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
- 3. The evidence received is sufficient to prove a violation of Section 301.452(b)(10), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §217.12 (6)(C)&(13).
- 4. Under Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code, the Board has the authority to accept the voluntary surrender of a license.
- 5. Under Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, as amended, the Board may impose conditions for reinstatement of licensure.
- 6. Any subsequent reinstatement of this license will be controlled by Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §213.26-.29, and any amendments thereof in

effect at the time of the reinstatement.

<u>ORDER</u>

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED and ORDERED that the VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of Registered Nurse License Number 660440, heretofore issued to TEDDY GLYNN HICKMAN, to practice nursing in the State of Texas, is accepted by the Texas Board of Nursing. In connection with this acceptance, the Board imposes the following conditions:

- 1. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT practice professional nursing, use the title "registered nurse" or the abbreviation "RN" or wear any insignia identifying himself as a registered nurse or use any designation which, directly or indirectly, would lead any person to believe that RESPONDENT is a registered nurse during the period in which the license is surrendered.
- 2. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT petition for reinstatement of licensure until: one (1) year has elapsed from the date of this Order.
- 3. Upon petitioning for reinstatement, RESPONDENT SHALL satisfy all then existing requirements for relicensure.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice nursing in the State of Texas.
