During open meeting held in Austin, Texas, on Tuesday, December 13, 2011, the Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee (hereinafter "Committee") heard the above-styled case, based on the failure of the Respondent to appear as required by 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE Ch. 213.

The Committee of the Texas Board of Nursing finds that notice of the facts or conduct alleged to warrant disciplinary action has been provided to Respondent in accordance with Texas Government Code § 2001.054(c) and Respondent has been given an opportunity to show compliance with all the requirements of the Nursing Practice Act, chapter 301 of the Texas Occupations Code, for retention of Respondent's license to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas.

The Committee finds that the Formal Charges were properly initiated and filed in accordance with section 301.458, Texas Occupations Code.

The Committee finds that after proper and timely Notice regarding the violations alleged in the Formal Charges was given to Respondent in this matter, Respondent has failed to appear in accordance with 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE Ch. 213.

The Committee finds that the Board is authorized to enter a default order pursuant to Texas Government Code § 2001.056.

The Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee, after review and due consideration, adopts the

proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law as stated in the Formal Charges which are attached hereto and incorporated by reference for all purposes and the Staff's recommended sanction of revocation by default. This Order will be properly served on all parties and all parties will be given an opportunity to file a motion for rehearing [22 Tex. ADMIN.CODE § 213.16(j)]. All parties have a right to judicial review of this Order.

All proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law filed by any party not specifically adopted herein are hereby denied.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Permanent Certificate Number 128542, previously issued to LISA LANETTE PATTERSON, to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas be, and the same is hereby, REVOKED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas.

FORMAL CHARGES

This is a disciplinary proceeding under Section 301.452(b), Texas Occupations Code. Respondent, LISA LANETTE PATTERSON, is a Vocational Nurse holding license number 128542, which is in delinquent status at the time of this pleading.

Written notice of the facts and conduct alleged to warrant adverse licensure action was sent to Respondent at Respondent's address of record and Respondent was given opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license prior to commencement of this proceeding.

CHARGE I.

On or about August 7, 1995, Respondent entered a plea of Guilty and was convicted of THEFT >=\$20 <\$500 (a Class B Misdemeanor offense Committed on April 11, 1995), in the County Criminal Court at Law No. 2 of Denton County, Texas, under Cause No. CR9503855D. As a result of the conviction, Respondent was sentenced to confinement in the Denton County Jail for a period of one hundred sixty (160) days, However, the imposition of the sentence was suspended and Respondent was placed on probation for a period of one (1) year. Additionally, Respondent was ordered to pay a fine and court costs.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Tex. Rev. Civ. STAT. ART. 4528c. Sec.10(a)(3)&(9)(eff 9/1/93), and is a violation of 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §239.11(28)(A)&(H)(eff. 4/95).

CHARGE II.

On or February 5, 2001, Respondent entered a plea of Nolo Contendere to THEFT PROP >=\$20 <\$500 BY CHECK (a Class B Misdemeanor offense committed on November 20, 1997), in the County Criminal Court at Law No. 2 of Denton County, Texas, under Cause No. CR9805488B. As a result, the proceedings were deferred without entering an adjudication of guilt, and Respondent was placed on probation for a period of nine (9) months. Additionally, Respondent was ordered to pay a fine and court costs.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 302.402(a)(10), Texas Occupations Code(eff. 9/1/99).

CHARGE III.

On or about November 1, 2005, Respondent entered a plea of Guilty and was convicted of POSSESSION WITH INTENT TO DELIVER A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE NAMELY; METHAMPHETAMINE (a 1st Degree Felony offense committed on January 25, 2004), in the 416th District Court of Collin County, Texas, under Cause No. 4168180704. As a result of the conviction, Respondent was sentenced to confinement in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice system for a period of ten (10) years, However, the imposition of the sentence was suspended and Respondent was placed on probation for a period of six (6) years. Additionally, Respondent was ordered to pay a fine, court costs and restitution in the amount of one hundred forty (\$140) dollars.

On or about August 30, 2007, a Judgement Revoking the community supervision Respondent had been granted on November 1, 2005, was entered in the 416th District Court of Collin County, Texas. The judgement was entered based on Findings by the Court that Respondent had violated the conditions of the community supervision. As a result, Respondent was adjudged guilty of POSSESSION WITH INTENT TO DELIVER A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE NAMELY; METHAMPHETAMINE, and sentenced to serve five (5) years in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice System and ordered to pay court costs.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(3)&(10), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(13). Moreover, the above offense mandates revocation of Respondent's license to practice nursing in accordance with Chapter 53.021 of the Texas Occupations Code.

NOTICE IS GIVEN that staff will present evidence in support of the recommended disposition of up to, and including revocation of Respondent's license to practice nursing in the State of Texas pursuant to the Nursing Practice Act, Chapter 301, Texas Occupations Code and the Board's rules, 22 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 213.27 - 213.33, and Tex. Occ. Code Ch. 53. Additionally, staff will seek to impose on Respondent the administrative costs of the proceeding pursuant to Section 301.461, Texas Occupations Code. The cost of proceedings shall include, but is not limited to, the cost paid by the Board to the State Office of Administrative Hearings and the Office of the Attorney General or other Board counsel for legal and investigative services, the cost of a court reporter and witnesses, reproduction of records, Board staff time, travel, and expenses. These shall be in an amount of at least one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1200.00).

NOTICE IS GIVEN that all statutes and rules cited in these Charges are incorporated as part of this pleading and can be found at the Board's website, www.bon.state.tx.us.

NOTICE IS GIVEN that to the extent applicable, based on the Formal Charges, the Board will rely on Adopted Disciplinary Guidelines for Criminal Conduct and on Adopted Disciplinary Sanction Policies for Nurses with Substance Abuse, Misuse, Substance Dependency, or other Substance Use Disorder, and for Theft, Fraud and Deception, which can be found at the Board's website, www.bon.state.tx.us.

NOTICE IS GIVEN that, based on the Formal Charges, the Board will rely on the Disciplinary Matrix, which can be found at www.bon.state.tx.us/disciplinaryaction/discp-matrix.html.
