ORDER OF THE BOARD

During open meeting held in Austin, Texas, on September 11, 2012, the Texas Board of Nursing Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee (hereinafter "Committee") heard the above-styled case, based on the failure of the Respondent to appear as required by 22 Tex. Admin. Code Ch. 213.

The Committee finds that notice of the facts or conduct alleged to warrant disciplinary action has been provided to Respondent in accordance with Texas Government Code § 2001.054(c) and Respondent has been given an opportunity to show compliance with all the requirements of the Nursing Practice Act, Chapter 301 of the Texas Occupations Code, for retention of Respondent's license(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

The Committee finds that the Formal Charges were properly initiated and filed in accordance with section 301.458, Texas Occupations Code.

The Committee finds that after proper and timely Notice regarding the violations alleged in the Formal Charges was given to Respondent in this matter, Respondent has failed to appear in accordance with 22 Tex. ADMIN. Code Ch. 213.

The Committee finds that the Board is authorized to enter a default order pursuant to Texas Government Code § 2001.056.

The Committee, after review and due consideration, adopts the proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law as stated in the Formal Charges which are attached hereto and incorporated by

reference for all purposes and the Staff's recommended sanction of revocation by default. This Order will be properly served on all parties and all parties will be given an opportunity to file a motion for rehearing [22 Tex. Admin.Code § 213.16(j)]. All parties have a right to judicial review of this Order.

All proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law filed by any party not specifically adopted herein are hereby denied.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Permanent Registered Nurse License Number 791623, previously issued to DEIDRA ALLAYNE TIDWELL, to practice nursing in the State of Texas be, and the same is/are hereby, REVOKED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

The cost of proceedings shall include, but is not limited to, the cost paid by the Board to the State Office of Administrative Hearings and the Office of the Attorney General or other Board counsel for legal and investigative services, the cost of a court reporter and witnesses, reproduction of records, Board staff time, travel, and expenses. These shall be in an amount of at least one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1200.00).

COUNT ONE

Pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §§19a-10, 19a-14, and 19a-14a the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") brings the following charges against Deidra Tidwell, R.N.:

- 1. Deidra Tidwell of Lynn, Alabama (hereinafter "respondent") is, and has been at all times referenced in this Statement of Charges, the holder of Connecticut license number 094269.
- 2. At all relevant times, respondent was employed as a registered nurse at Windham Hospital (hereinafter "facility") in Windham, Connecticut.
- 3. In November 2010 while working as a registered nurse at the facility, respondent:
 - a. diverted Morphine and/or Hydromorphone from patient stock;
 - failed to properly follow hospital policies and/or procedures for medication administration:
 - failed to completely, properly and/or accurately document medical or hospital records;
 and/or,
 - d, failed to properly waste and/or return medications.
- 4. The above facts constitute grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes, §20-99(b), including but not limited to, §20-99(b)(2).

COUNT TWO

- 5. Paragraphs 1 and 2 are incorporated by reference as if set forth in full.
- On or about November 17 and/or 18, 2010 while working as a registered nurse at Windham Hospital in Windham, Connecticut, respondent engaged in inappropriate and/or erratic conduct during working hours.
- 7. The above facts constitute grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §20-99(b), including but not limited to:
 - a. §20-99(b)(2);
 - b. §20-99(b)(3); and/or,
 - c. §20-99(b)(4).
