On this day the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Board, considered the matter of KANDICE KAY MOORE, Vocational Nurse License Number 131549, hereinafter referred to as Respondent. This action was taken in accordance with Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code.

Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal proceedings, notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Order.

The Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Prior to the institution of Agency proceedings, notice of the matters specified below in these Findings of Fact was provided to Respondent and Respondent was given an opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license(s).
2. Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal proceedings, notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Order.
3. Respondent's license to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas is currently in delinquent status.
4. Respondent received a Certificate in Vocational Nursing from Indiana Vocational Technical College, Lafayette, Indiana on September 21, 1975. Respondent was licensed to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas on January 28, 1991.
5. Respondent's vocational nursing employment history is unknown.
6. On or about June 21, 2012, the Voluntary Surrender of Respondent's license to practice nursing in the State of New Hampshire was accepted by the New Hampshire Board of Nursing, Concord, New Hampshire. A copy of the New Hampshire Board of Nursing

Voluntary Surrender of License dated June 21, 2012, is attached and incorporated, by reference, as part of this Order.

7. Regarding the conduct outlined in Finding of Fact Number Six (6), Respondent states that she is truly remorseful for causing the endangerment of a patient under her care and for not being honest in reporting the information to those in charge. Respondent states that she is thankful the patient had no lasting harm, and the mistake is something that she has been reliving many times. Respondent states that she has not worked as a nurse since September 2011, and due to health reasons she does not plan to work as a nurse in any state in the future.
8. Respondent, by her signature to this Order, expresses her desire to voluntarily surrender her license(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451-301.555, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
3. The evidence received is sufficient cause pursuant to Section 301.452(b)(8), Texas Occupations Code, to take disciplinary action against Vocational Nurse License Number 131549, heretofore issued to KANDICE KAY MOORE, including revocation of Respondent's license(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas.
5. Under Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code, the Board has the authority to accept the voluntary surrender of a license.
6. Under Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, as amended, the Board may impose conditions for reinstatement of licensure.
7. Any subsequent reinstatement of this license will be controlled by Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §213.26-.29, and any amendments thereof in effect at the time of the reinstatement.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED and ORDERED that the VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of Vocational Nurse License Number 131549, heretofore issued to KANDICE KAY

MOORE, to practice nursing in the State of Texas, is accepted by the Texas Board of Nursing. In connection with this acceptance, the Board imposes the following conditions:

1. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT practice vocational nursing, use the title "vocational nurse" or the abbreviation "LVN" or wear any insignia identifying herself as a vocational nurse or use any designation which, directly or indirectly, would lead any person to believe that RESPONDENT is a vocational nurse during the period in which the license is surrendered.
2. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT petition for reinstatement of licensure until: one (1) year has elapsed from the date of this Order.
3. Upon petitioning for reinstatement, RESPONDENT SHALL satisfy all then existing requirements for relicensure.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

I waive judicial review of this Order. I understand that this Order becomes final when accepted by the Executive Director at which time the terms of this Order become effective and a copy will be mailed to me.

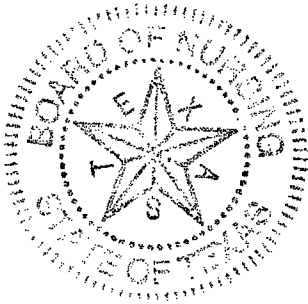

VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF LICENSE

Recognizing that professional misconduct allegations are now pending against me before the New Hampshire Board of Nursing ("Board") concerning the complaint filed by Glenduff Home alleging that I inadvertently gave a resident the wrong medication and failed to report the error, I, Kandice Moore, LPN, hereby voluntarily surrender my New Hampshire license (#014350-22) effective on the date that the Board accepts this offer of voluntary surrender.

By voluntarily surrendering my license, I understand that:

1. I relinquish all rights and privileges to practice nursing in the State of New Hampshire effective upon the Board's acceptance of this voluntary surrender.
2. I admit that this license surrender has occurred in settlement of pending disciplinary charges.
3. I admit to no violations of RSA 326-B:37, II but recognize that the fact of my voluntary surrender will be distributed by the Board as a disciplinary action.
4. Should I again seek licensure in the State of New Hampshire, I must meet and shall bear the burden of proving compliance with all of the standards and prerequisites then required by the Board for new applicants, including professional character requirements.
5. I understand that the pending disciplinary allegations shall be resolved in any future licensure application I may submit in New Hampshire. I hereby specifically waive any statute of limitations or laches defense, which might then be available as to these misconduct allegations.
6. I understand that if the Board chooses to accept my surrender of license, this document shall be distributed to all relevant licensing authorities and professional societies in the same

manner as a final decision making specific finding of professional misconduct. I recognize that the fact of my voluntary surrender will be distributed by the Board as a disciplinary action. I further understand that this document shall become a permanent part of my file, and will be maintained by the Board as a public document.

I voluntarily submit this surrender of license to the Board and state that no promises or representations have been made to me other than those terms and conditions expressly stated herein.
