On this day the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Board, considered the matter of ELIZABETH ANN WALLACE, Vocational Nurse License Number 205606, hereinafter referred to as Respondent. This action was taken in accordance with Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code.

Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal proceedings, notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Order.

The Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Prior to the institution of Agency proceedings, notice of the matters specified below in these Findings of Fact was provided to Respondent and Respondent was given an opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license(s).
2. Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal proceedings, notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Order.
3. Respondent is currently licensed to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas.
4. Respondent received a Certificate in Vocational Nursing from Weatherford College, Weatherford, Texas on August 11, 2006. Respondent was licensed to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas on August 31, 2006
5. Respondent's vocational nursing employment history includes:

6. On or about June 22, 2012, Respondent entered a plea of guilty to POSS CS PG 1 < 1G, (a State Jail Felony committed on May 29, 2011), in the 415th Judicial District Court of Parker County, Weatherford, Texas, under Cause Number CR12-0064. As a result of Respondent's guilty plea, the proceedings against her were deferred, without entering an adjudication of guilt, and she was placed on Community Supervision for a period of three (3) years. Additionally, Respondent was ordered to pay court costs, a fine, and restitution in the amount of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00).
7. Formal Charges were filed on September 7, 2012.
8. Formal Charges were mailed to Respondent on September 12, 2012.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451-301.555, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
3. The evidence received is sufficient to prove violation(s) of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(13).
4. The evidence received is sufficient cause pursuant to Section 301.452(b)(3) & (10), Texas Occupations Code, to take disciplinary action Vocational Nurse License Number 205606, heretofore issued to ELIZABETH ANN WALLACE, including revocation of Respondent's license(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas.
5. Under Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code, the Board has the authority to accept the voluntary surrender of a license.
6. Under Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, as amended, the Board may impose conditions for reinstatement of licensure.
7. Any subsequent reinstatement of this license will be controlled by Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §213.26-.29, and any amendments thereof in effect at the time of the reinstatement.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED and ORDERED that the VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of Vocational Nurse License Number 205606, heretofore issued to ELIZABETH ANN WALLACE, to practice nursing in the State of Texas, is accepted by the Texas Board of Nursing. In connection with this acceptance, the Board imposes the following conditions:

1. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT practice vocational nursing, use the title "vocational nurse" or the abbreviation "LVN" or wear any insignia identifying herself as a vocational nurse or use any designation which, directly or indirectly, would lead any person to believe that RESPONDENT is a vocational nurse during the period in which the license is surrendered.
2. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT petition for reinstatement of licensure until one (1) year has elapsed from the date of this Order.
3. Upon petitioning for reinstatement, RESPONDENT SHALL satisfy all then existing requirements for relicensure.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

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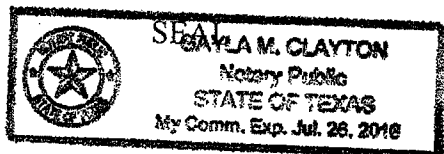
RESPONDENT'S CERTIFICATION


