On December 18, 2012, during open meeting in Austin, Texas, an Order was ratified by the Texas Board of Nursing Eligibility & Disciplinary Committee (Board) for Heather Michelle Reaves. However, the Order failed to include the date of the meeting. Upon notice and hearing, administrative agencies, like the Courts, have the power to enter nunc pro tunc orders where it can be seen by reference to a record that what was intended to be entered, but was omitted by inadvertence or mistake, can be corrected upon satisfactory proof of its rendition provided that no intervening rights will be prejudiced. *Railroad Comm'n v. McClain*, 356 S.W.2d 330, 334 (Tex. App.--Austin 1962, no writ) (citing *Frankfort Ky. Nat. Gas Co. v. City of Frankfort*, 276 Ky. 199, 123 S.W.2d 270, 272).

The Executive Director, as agent of the Texas Board of Nursing, after review and due consideration of the record and the facts therein, invalidates the Order of the Board that omitted the date of the Board's meeting and submits and enters the corrected Order of the Board, which correctly includes reference to the date of the Board's meeting. No other changes to the Order have been made. Ms. Reaves received due process regarding her license; therefore, her rights have not been prejudiced.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the corrected Order of the Board is hereby approved and entered on the dates set forth below.

### FORMAL CHARGES

This is a disciplinary proceeding under Section 301.452(b), Texas Occupations Code. Respondent, HEATHER MICHELLE REAVES, is a Vocational Nurse holding License Number 183821, which is in current status at the time of this pleading.

Written notice of the facts and conduct alleged to warrant adverse licensure action was sent to Respondent at Respondent's address of record and Respondent was given opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license prior to commencement of this proceeding.

#### CHARGE I.

On or about March 9, 2011, Respondent was indicted for the offense of "Possession of a Controlled Substance (Methamphetamine)," a State Jail Felony (committed on October 2, 2010) by the Grand Jury of the 8th Judicial District Court of Hopkins County, Texas, under cause number 1122086.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(13).

#### CHARGE II.

On or about January 9, 2012, Respondent pled no contest to the offense of "Possession of Drug Paraphernalia," a Class C Misdemeanor (committed on July 8, 2010) in the County Criminal Court No. 8 of Dallas County, Texas, under cause number MA1025253-J. Adjudication of guilt was deferred and Respondent was placed on probation for a period of three (3) months and ordered to pay a fine and court costs.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(13).

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### CHARGE III.

On or about May 7, 2012, Respondent pled Nolo Contendere to the offense of "Possession of Drug Paraphernalia" a Class C Misdemeanor (committed on November 16, 2011) in the Municipal Court of the City of Irving, Dallas County, Texas, under cause number 8008150101. Respondent was ordered to pay a fine and court costs.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(13).

### CHARGE IV.

On or about June 12, 2012, Respondent pled guilty to the offense of "Possession of Controlled Substance," a State Jail Felony (committed on February 24, 2011) in the 40th Judicial District Court of Ellis County, Texas, under cause number 36141CR. Adjudication of guilt was deferred and Respondent was placed on probation for a period of four (4) years and ordered to pay a fine, court costs and restitution.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(3)&(10), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(13).

NOTICE IS GIVEN that staff will present evidence in support of the recommended disposition of up to, and including, revocation of Respondent's license/s to practice nursing in the State of Texas pursuant to the Nursing Practice Act, Chapter 301, Texas Occupations Code and the Board's rules, 22 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 213.27 - 213.33 and TEX. OCC. CODE Ch. 53. Additionally, staff will seek to impose on Respondent the administrative costs of the proceeding pursuant to Section 301.461, Texas Occupations Code. The cost of proceedings shall include, but is not limited to, the cost paid by the Board to the State Office of Administrative Hearings and the Office of the Attorney General or other Board counsel for legal and investigative services, the cost of a court reporter and witnesses, reproduction of records, Board staff time, travel, and expenses. These shall be in an amount of at least one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1200.00).



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
