

ORDER OF THE BOARD

On this day, the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Board, accepted the voluntary surrender of Registered Nurse License Number 665580, issued to PETER ANTHONY EVENBLY, hereinafter referred to as Respondent. This action was taken in accordance with Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code.

Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal proceedings, notice and hearing.

The Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is currently licensed to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas.
- 2. Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal proceedings, notice and hearing.
- 3. Respondent received a Diploma in Nursing from Mercy College of Health Sciences, Des Moines, Iowa on May 1, 1992. Respondent was licensed to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas on December 22, 1999.
- 4. Respondent's complete nursing employment history is unknown.
- 5. On or about March 3, 2011, Respondent was accused of the rape of a patient while employed as a Registered Nurse with Shelby Baptist Medical Center, Alabaster, Alabama. As a result of this accusation, Respondent received a Grand Jury Indictment by the Shelby County Grand Jury, Alabaster, Alabama in February, 2012. Respondent was subsequently arrested in the State of Texas and extradited to Alabama, where he was charged with one (1) count of FIRST DEGREE RAPE and one (1) count of FIRST DEGREE SODOMY. As a result of this arrest and charge, on or about October 29, 2012, Respondent received a Voluntary Surrender from the Alabama State Board of Nursing wherein Respondent's license to practice professional nursing in the State of Alabama was accepted for Voluntary Surrender. A copy of the Voluntary Surrender issued by the Alabama State Board of Nursing dated October 29, 2012, is attached and incorporated by reference as part of this Order.

- 6. Formal Charges were filed on December 6, 2012.
- 7. Formal Charges were mailed to Respondent on December 7, 2012.
- 8. On December 27, 2012, the Board received a notarized statement from Respondent voluntarily surrendering the right to practice nursing in Texas. A copy of Respondent's notarized statement, dated December 14, 2012, is attached and incorporated herein by reference as part of this Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451-301.555, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
- 3. The evidence received is sufficient to prove violation(s) of 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(13).
- 4. The evidence received is sufficient cause pursuant to Section 301.452(b)(8)&(10), Texas Occupations Code, to take disciplinary action against Registered Nurse License Number 665580, heretofore issued to PETER ANTHONY EVENBLY, including revocation of Respondent's license(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas.
- 5. Under Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code, the Board has the authority to accept the voluntary surrender of a license.
- 6. Under Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, the Board may impose conditions for reinstatement of licensure.
- 7. Any subsequent reinstatement of this license will be controlled by Section 301.452 (b), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 TAC§§213.26-.29, and any amendments thereof in effect at the time of the reinstatement.

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ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the voluntary surrender of Registered Nurse License Number 665580, heretofore issued to PETER ANTHONY EVENBLY, to practice nursing in the State of Texas, is accepted by the Executive Director on behalf of the Texas Board of Nursing. In connection with this acceptance, the Board imposes the following conditions:

- 1. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT practice professional nursing, use the title of registered nurse or the abbreviation RN or wear any insignia identifying himself as a registered nurse or use any designation which, directly or indirectly, would lead any person to believe that RESPONDENT is a registered nurse during the period in which the license is surrendered.
- 2. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT petition for reinstatement of licensure until: one (1) year has elapsed from the date of this Order.
- 3. Upon petitioning for reinstatement, RESPONDENT SHALL satisfy all then existing requirements for relicensure.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

The undersigned holder of licensure to practice nursing in the State of Alabama, pursuant to § 610-X-8-.05(4) of the Alabama Board of Nursing Administrative Code hereby freely, knowingly and voluntarily surrenders said license to the Alabama Board of Nursing. I further understand that this surrender shall have the same effect as a revocation of my license, and I knowingly forfeit and relinquish all right, title and privilege of practicing nursing in the State of Alabama, unless and until such time as my license may be reinstated.

I understand that I have a right to a hearing in this matter, and I hereby freely, knowingly and voluntarily waive such right. I also understand that should any request for reinstatement be entertained by the Alabama Board of Nursing, the Alabama Board of Nursing shall have access to the entire investigative file in this matter.

I further acknowledge that the only promises or representations made to me by the Alabama Board of Nursing or its representatives are that upon receipt of proper proof and evidence of my rehabilitation, the Alabama Board of Nursing will give due consideration to an application for reinstatement of license at such time as is allowed by law. I fully understand that as a condition for reinstatement, I must demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Alabama Board of Nursing that I am capable of safely and competently resuming the practice of nursing in accordance with the laws of the State of Alabama.

This voluntary surrender shall become effective immediately upon acceptance thereof by the Alabama Board of Nursing. I understand that this document will be considered to be a public record entered as the final disposition of disciplinary proceedings presently pending against me, that this action shall be considered to be and may be recorded as a Final Order of the Board, and that this action will be reported as a disciplinary action to the Healthcare Integrity Protection Databank and the National Council of State Boards of Nursing.
