ORDER OF THE BOARD

During open meeting held in Austin, Texas, on, the Texas Board of Nursing Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee (hereinafter "Committee") heard the above-styled case, based on the failure of the Respondent to appear as required by 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE Ch. 213.

The Committee finds that notice of the facts or conduct alleged to warrant disciplinary action has been provided to Respondent in accordance with Texas Government Code § 2001.054(c) and Respondent has been given an opportunity to show compliance with all the requirements of the Nursing Practice Act, Chapter 301 of the Texas Occupations Code, for retention of Respondent's license(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

The Committee finds that the Formal Charges were properly initiated and filed in accordance with section 301.458, Texas Occupations Code.

The Committee finds that after proper and timely Notice regarding the violations alleged in the Formal Charges was given to Respondent in this matter, Respondent has failed to appear in accordance with 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE Ch. 213.

The Committee finds that the Board is authorized to enter a default order pursuant to Texas Government Code § 2001.056.

The Committee, after review and due consideration, adopts the proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law as stated in the Formal Charges which are attached hereto and incorporated by reference for all purposes and the Staff's recommended sanction of revocation by default. This Order

will be properly served on all parties and all parties will be given an opportunity to file a motion for rehearing [22 Tex. ADMIN.CODE § 213.16(j)]. All parties have a right to judicial review of this Order.

All proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law filed by any party not specifically adopted herein are hereby denied.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that, Permanent Vocational Nurse License Number 221611, previously issued to ERIKA MARIE LLANOS, to practice nursing in the State of Texas be, and the same is/are hereby, REVOKED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

FORMAL CHARGES

This is a disciplinary proceeding under Section 301.452(b), Texas Occupations Code. Respondent, ERIKA MARIE LLANOS, is a Vocational Nurse holding License Number 221611, which is in current status at the time of this pleading.

Written notice of the facts and conduct alleged to warrant adverse licensure action was sent to Respondent at Respondent's address of record and Respondent was given opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license prior to commencement of this proceeding.

CHARGE I.

On or about December 30, 2010 through January 13, 2011, while employed as a Private Duty Nurse with Melody Home Care, McAllen, Texas, Respondent failed to submit documentation of nursing care provided to Patient Medical Record Number 1087 PDN, as required. Respondent's conduct was likely to injure the patient from clinical care decisions formulated based upon incomplete assessment information.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10)&(13), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §217.11(1)(A),(1)(B),(1)(D)&(2)(A) and 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(1)(A)&(4).

CHARGE II.

On or about January 10, 2011 through January 14, 2011, while employed as a Private Duty Nurse with Melody Home Care, McAllen, Texas, Respondent failed to notify her supervisor that she would not be providing care to Patient Medical Record Number 1087 PDN, as scheduled and assigned. Respondent's conduct unnecessarily exposed the patient to risk of injury due to lack of nursing care and supervision.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10)&(13), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §217.11(1)(A),(1)(B),(1)(P)&(2)(A) and 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(1)(A)&(4).

CHARGE III.

On or about July 11, 2011 through July 23, 2011, while employed as a home health nurse with Good Shepherd PHC, LLC, Edcouch, Texas, Respondent failed to provide skilled nursing visits to patients, as scheduled and assigned. Respondent's conduct unnecessarily exposed patients to risk of injury due to lack of nursing care.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10)&(13), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §217.11(1)(A),(1)(B),(1)(P)&(2)(A) and 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(1)(A)&(4).

CHARGE IV.

On or about October 21, 2011, while employed as a home health nurse with Epic Medstaff, Austin, Texas, Respondent failed to intervene and/or report to the physician or RN supervisor that Patient Medical Record Number 1640, had a clogged gastrostomy button and was unable to receive his formula feedings, as ordered. Respondent's conduct was likely to injure the patient due to inadequate nutrition.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10)&(13), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.11(1)(A),(1)(D),(1)(M),(1)(P)&(2)(A) and 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(1)(A)&(4).

NOTICE IS GIVEN that staff will present evidence in support of the recommended disposition of up to, and including, revocation of Respondent's license/s to practice nursing in the State of Texas pursuant to the Nursing Practice Act, Chapter 301, Texas Occupations Code and the Board's rules, 22 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 213.27 - 213.33. Additionally, staff will seek to impose on Respondent the administrative costs of the proceeding pursuant to Section 301.461, Texas Occupations Code. The cost of proceedings shall include, but is not limited to, the cost paid by the Board to the State Office of Administrative Hearings and the Office of the Attorney General or other Board counsel for legal and investigative services, the cost of a court reporter and witnesses, reproduction of records, Board staff time, travel, and expenses. These shall be in an amount of at least one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1200.00).
