ORDER OF THE BOARD

During open meeting held in Austin, Texas, on , the Texas Board of Nursing Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee (hereinafter "Committee") heard the above-styled case, based on the failure of the Respondent to appear as required by 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE Ch. 213.

The Committee finds that notice of the facts or conduct alleged to warrant disciplinary action has been provided to Respondent in accordance with Texas Government Code § 2001.054(c) and Respondent has been given an opportunity to show compliance with all the requirements of the Nursing Practice Act, Chapter 301 of the Texas Occupations Code, for retention of Respondent's license(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

The Committee finds that the Formal Charges were properly initiated and filed in accordance with section 301.458, Texas Occupations Code.

The Committee finds that after proper and timely Notice regarding the violations alleged in the Formal Charges was given to Respondent in this matter, Respondent has failed to appear in accordance with 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE Ch. 213.

The Committee finds that the Board is authorized to enter a default order pursuant to Texas Government Code § 2001.056.

The Committee, after review and due consideration, adopts the proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law as stated in the Formal Charges which are attached hereto and incorporated by reference for all purposes and the Staff's recommended sanction of revocation by default. This

Order will be properly served on all parties and all parties will be given an opportunity to file a motion for rehearing [22 TEX. ADMIN.CODE § 213.16(j)]. All parties have a right to judicial review of this Order.


All proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law filed by any party not specifically adopted herein are hereby denied.



Dear Johnny Lynn Reed:

Enclosed are Formal Charges which have been filed against you because your pending alleged violation(s) of Section 301.452(b) of the Nursing Practice Act, Texas Occupations Code, have not been resolved. Within three weeks from the date of this letter, you must file a written answer to each charge admitting or denying each allegation. If you intend to deny only part of an allegation, you must specify so much of it as is true and deny only the remainder. Your answer shall also include any other matter, whether of law or fact, upon which you intend to rely for your defense. Send your written answer to the attention of Terry Washington, Investigator, at the above address. You may obtain legal counsel at your own expense.

FAILURE TO FILE A WRITTEN ANSWER TO THE FORMAL CHARGES, EITHER PERSONALLY OR BY LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE, WILL RESULT IN THE ALLEGATIONS CONTAINED IN THE FORMAL CHARGES BEING ADMITTED AS TRUE AND THE PROPOSED RECOMMENDATION OF STAFF WILL BE GRANTED BY DEFAULT.

If a written answer to the Formal Charges is not received within three weeks from the date of this letter, this matter will proceed on a default basis and it will be staff's recommendation that a default order be entered revoking your license(s) and/or nurse licensure compact privilege(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

The result of any disciplinary action, including any default order or formal disposition (Board Order), is public information. Dispositions, including default orders and formal dispositions, will appear in the Board's quarterly newsletter and will be reported to the National Council of State Boards of



FORMAL CHARGES

This is a disciplinary proceeding under Section 301.452(b), Texas Occupations Code. Respondent, JOHNNY LYNN REED, is a Vocational Nurse holding License Number 146237, which is in current status at the time of this pleading.

Written notice of the facts and conduct alleged to warrant adverse licensure action was sent to Respondent at Respondent's address of record and Respondent was given opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license prior to commencement of this proceeding.

CHARGE I.

On or about December 20, 1993, Respondent submitted an Application for Licensure by Examination to the Texas Board of Vocational Nurse Examiners in which he provided false, deceptive, and/or misleading information, in that he answered "No" to the question: "Have you ever been convicted and/or pled guilty to a felony or misdemeanor other than a minor traffic violations?"

Respondent failed to disclose that:

On or about February 16, 1978, Respondent was convicted of DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED, a misdemeanor offense committed on February 15, 1978, in the County Court, Cooke County, Texas, under Cause No. 22669.

On or about July 13, 1978, Respondent pled Guilty to and was found Guilty of DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED, a misdemeanor offense committed on July 13, 1978, in the County Court, Cooke County, Texas, under Cause No. 23098.

On or about June 6, 1979, Respondent was found Guilty of DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED, a misdemeanor offense, in the County Court at Law, Hays County, Texas, under Cause No. 10,604.

On or about March 3, 1980, Respondent pled Guilty to and was convicted of THEFT, a misdemeanor offense, in the Criminal County Court 1, Dallas County, Texas, under Case No. M-7900932A.

On or about February 15, 1980, Respondent pled Guilty to DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED, a misdemeanor offense committed on December 16, 1979, in the County Court, Cooke County, Texas, under Cause No. 24362.

On or about November 20, 1981, Respondent pled Guilty to and was found Guilty PUBLIC INTOXICATION, a misdemeanor offense, in the County Court at Law, Grayson County, Texas, under Cause No. 81-1968.

On or about August 20, 1984, Respondent pled Guilty to and was found Guilty of THEFT 20-200-CHECK, a misdemeanor offense committed on March 6, 1983, in the County Criminal Court No. 2, Tarrant County, Texas, under Cause No. 219956.

On or about February 17, 1987, Respondent was found Guilty of DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED, a misdemeanor offense committed on December 14, 1985, in the County Criminal Court No. 4, Tarrant County, Texas, under Cause No. 0274942.

On or about December 6, 1989, Respondent pled Guilty to and was found Guilty of DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED, a misdemeanor offense committed on May 28, 1989, in the County Criminal Court No. 4, Tarrant County, Texas, under Cause No. 0375042.

On or about December 20, 1990, Respondent pled Guilty to and was found Guilty of THEFT 20-200-CHECK, a misdemeanor offense committed on May 8, 1990, in the County Criminal Court No. 5, Tarrant County, Texas, under Cause No. 0422402.

Finally, on or about May 22, 1992, Respondent pled Guilty to and was convicted of DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED, a misdemeanor offense committed on March 24, 1991, in the County Criminal Court No. 7, Tarrant County, Texas, under Cause No. 436727.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with TEX. REV. CIV. STAT. ART. 4528c, Sec. 10(a)(2)&(9)(eff. 9/1/1993), and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §239.11(8)(eff. 9/1/1993).

NOTICE IS GIVEN that staff will present evidence in support of the recommended disposition of up to, and including, revocation of Respondent's license/s to practice nursing in the State of Texas pursuant to the Nursing Practice Act, Chapter 301, Texas Occupations Code and the Board's rules, 22 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 213.27 - 213.33. Additionally, staff will seek to impose on Respondent the administrative costs of the proceeding pursuant to Section 301.461, Texas Occupations Code. The cost of proceedings shall include, but is not limited to, the cost paid by the Board to the State Office of Administrative Hearings and the Office of the Attorney General or other Board counsel for legal and investigative services, the cost of a court reporter and witnesses, reproduction of records, Board staff time, travel, and expenses. These shall be in an amount of at least one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1200.00).


