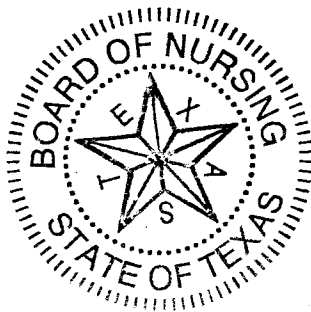

ORDER OF THE BOARD VACATING PRIOR ORDER TO SUSPEND LICENSE

On this day, the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the "Board," vacates the **SUSPENSION** of Licensed Vocational Nurse No. **70332**, issued to **RICHARD G. RAMIREZ**, hereinafter referred to as Respondent. This action is taken in accordance with chapters 231 and 232 of the Texas Family Code.

On June 13, 2012, Respondent's license to practice vocational nursing was Suspended by the Attorney General of the State of Texas. On March 26, 2013, the Board received an Order from the Attorney General vacating the prior Order that suspended the Respondent's license. A copy of this Order is attached and incorporated herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Suspension of License No. 70332, heretofore issued to RICHARD G. RAMIREZ to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas, is *Vacated*, and Licensed Vocational Nurse No. 70332 is hereby *Restored* to the Respondent, if Respondent is otherwise qualified for the license.

**ORDER GRANTING MOTION
TO STAY SUSPENSION OF LICENSE**

The Office of the Attorney General of Texas, Petitioner, filed a Motion to Stay Order Suspending License on March 20, 2013, in the above styled case. Respondent, **RICHARD RAMIREZ**, has paid all delinquent child support, has established a satisfactory payment record, or good cause otherwise exists to stay the Decision and Order issued August 16, 2010, suspending one or more licenses issued to Respondent by the Texas Department of Public Safety and Texas Board of Nursing. The Administrative Law Judge concludes the motion should be granted.

It is therefore, **ORDERED** that the Motion to Stay Order Suspending License is **GRANTED**, and the order suspending Respondent's license(s) is hereby **STAYED**. This stay shall remain subject to a motion to revoke for noncompliance in accordance with Tex. Family Code § 232.012. This order shall be promptly delivered to the licensing agency for observance. Upon payment of any fee required by the licensing agency under Tex. Family Code §232.014, the agency will issue the affected license to **RICHARD RAMIREZ** if he is otherwise qualified for the license.
