
## BEFORE THE TEXAS BOARD OF NURSING

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## ORDER GRANTING PETITIONER'S REQUEST FOR EXCEPTION

On this day, the Executive Director, on behalf of the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the "Board", considered Petitioner's Request for Exception filed in the above-styled matter. An Agreed Order of the Board was entered on February 12, 2013, for ERICCA SUE BERRY, Pediatric Nurse Practitioner and Registered Nurse License Number 751749. Petitioner filed a Request for Exception to the Agreed Order on May 6, 2013. After review and due consideration of the Petitioner's request, and pursuant to 22 Tex. Admin. Code §211.7(h), the Executive Director of the Board GRANTS Petitioner's Therefore, Petitioner is required to comply with and complete all of the Request for Exception. requirements of the February 12, 2013, Agreed Order, except that the bolded paragraph found on Page Six (6) of the Order is modified as follows:

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, SHOULD PETITIONER PRACTICE AS A NURSE IN THE STATE OF TEXAS, PETITIONER WILL PROVIDE DIRECT PATIENT CARE AND PRACTICE IN A HOSPITAL, NURSING HOME, OR OTHER CLINICAL SETTING A MINIMUM OF SIXTY-FOUR (64) HOURS PER MONTH UNDER THE FOLLOWING STIPULATIONS FOR ONE (1) YEAR OF EMPLOYMENT WITH THE EXCEPTION OF PETITIONER'S

EMPLOYMENT WITH ACUTE KIDS, FRISCO, TEXAS, WHEREBY PETITIONER WILL PROVIDE DIRECT PATIENT CARE A MINIMUM OF FORTY-EIGHT (48) HOURS PER MONTH. THE LENGTH OF THE STIPULATION PERIOD WILL BE EXTENDED UNTIL SUCH TWELVE (12) MONTHS HAVE ELAPSED. PERIODS OF UNEMPLOYMENT OR OF EMPLOYMENT THAT DO NOT REQUIRE THE USE OF A REGISTERED NURSE (RN) OR A VOCATIONAL NURSE (LVN) LICENSE, AS APPROPRIATE, WILL NOT APPLY TO THIS STIPULATION PERIOD:
