On this day the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Board, considered the matter of REINIER JIM DEJESUS, Vocational Nurse License Number 195313, hereinafter referred to as Respondent. This action was taken in accordance with Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code.

Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal proceedings, notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Order.

The Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Prior to the institution of Agency proceedings, notice of the matters specified below in these Findings of Fact was provided to Respondent and Respondent was given an opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license(s).
- 2. Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal proceedings, notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Order.
- 3. Respondent holds a licensed to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas, which is in delinquent status.
- 4. Respondent received a Certificate in Vocational Nursing from South Texas Community College, Edinburg, Texas on August 5, 2004. Respondent was licensed to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas on September 30, 2004.
- 5. Respondent's vocational nursing employment history is unknown.

- 6. On or about January 7, 2013, Respondent entered a plea of Guilty to INDECENCY WITH A CHILD SEXUAL CONTACT, a lesser included offense, 2nd Degree Felony offense committed on July 31, 2010, in the 275th Judicial District Court of Hidalgo County, Texas, under Cause No. CR-3567-12-E. As a result of the plea, the proceedings against Respondent were deferred without entering an adjudication of Guilt, and Respondent was placed on probation for a period of five (5) years and was ordered to pay a fine and court costs.
- 7. In response to Finding of Fact Number Six (6), Respondent states, he did have a one time only physical relationship with a minor. He has been and will continue to seek treatment to avoid further lapses in judgement.
- 8. Formal Charges were filed on May 17, 2013
- 9. Charges were mailed to Respondent on May 17, 2013.

Respondent, by his signature to this Order, expresses his desire to voluntarily surrender his license(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451-301.555, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
- 3. The evidence received is sufficient to prove violation(s) of and 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(13).
- 4. The evidence received is sufficient cause pursuant to Section 301.4535(a)&(b), and Section 301.452(b)(3)&(10), Texas Occupations Code, to take disciplinary action against Vocational Nurse License Number 195313, heretofore issued to REINIER JIM DEJESUS, including revocation of Respondent's license(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas.
- 5. Under Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code, the Board has the authority to accept the voluntary surrender of a license.
- 6. Under Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, as amended, the Board may impose conditions for reinstatement of licensure.
- 7. Any subsequent reinstatement of this license will be controlled by Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §213.26-.29, and any amendments thereof in effect at the time of the reinstatement.

#### ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED and ORDERED that the VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of Vocational Nurse License Number 195313, heretofore issued to REINIER JIM DEJESUS, to practice nursing in the State of Texas, is accepted by the Texas Board of Nursing. In connection with this acceptance, the Board imposes the following conditions:

- 1. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT practice vocational nursing, use the title "vocational nurse" or the abbreviation "LVN" or wear any insignia identifying himself as a vocational nurse or use any designation which, directly or indirectly, would lead any person to believe that RESPONDENT is a vocational nurse during the period in which the license is surrendered.
- 2. Pursuant to TEX. OCC. CODE Section §301.4535(c), RESPONDENT SHALL NOT petition for reinstatement of licensure until at least 5 years has passed from the date the Respondent successfully complete and is dismissed from community supervision.
- 3. Upon petitioning for reinstatement, RESPONDENT SHALL satisfy all then existing requirements for relicensure.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice nursing in the State of Texas.
