ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

A public meeting of the Texas Board of Nursing was held on December 19, 2014 at 333 Guadalupe, Room 3-460, Austin, Texas, in which the Temporary Suspension of Permanent Vocational Nurse License Number 196524, issued to RICARDO MIGUEL PACHECO was considered pursuant to Section 301.455, Texas Occupations Code. Staff of the Texas Board of Nursing appeared and presented information and evidence concerning the conduct of RICARDO MIGUEL PACHECO and whether his continued practice as a nurse would constitute a continuing and imminent threat to the public welfare.

After review and due consideration of the evidence and information presented, the Board finds that the following charges are substantiated:

CHARGE I.

On or about August 15, 2014, while employed as a Licensed Vocational Nurse with Mission Trail Baptist Hospital, San Antonio, Texas, and assigned to the Emergency Department, Respondent exposed his genitals to Patient Medical Record Number 1422701528 several times and placed her hand on his penis. In addition, Respondent informed Patient Medical Record Number 1422701528, she was making him "hot", and advised her the interaction was confidential and therapeutic. Subsequently, when questioned by hospital staff, he admitted to exposing his genitals to Patient Medical Record Number 1422701528. Respondent's conduct was likely to cause emotional injury to the patient and could have interfered or disrupted this patient's treatment.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10)&(13), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §217.11(1)(B)&(1)(J), and 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(1)(A),(1)(B),(4),(6)(C),(6)(D)&(6)(E).

CHARGE II.

On or about August 15, 2014, while employed as a Licensed Vocational Nurse with Mission Trail Baptist Hospital, San Antonio, Texas, and assigned to the Emergency Department, Respondent placed a Foley catheter in Patient Medical Record Number 1422701528 without a female present. Subsequently, Respondent told Patient Medical Record Number 1422701528 several times she was clean "down there." Respondent's conduct was likely to cause emotional injury to the patient and could have interfered or disrupted this patient's treatment.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10)&(13), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §217.11(1)(B)&(1)(J), and 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(1)(A),(1)(B),(4),(6)(C),(6)(D)&(6)(E).

The Texas Board of Nursing further finds that, given the nature of the charges, the continued practice of nursing by RICARDO MIGUEL PACHECO constitutes a continuing and imminent threat to public welfare and that the temporary suspension of Permanent Vocational Nurse License Number 196524, is justified pursuant to Section 301.455, TEXAS OCCUPATIONS CODE.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Permanent Vocational Nurse License Number 196524, issued to RICARDO MIGUEL PACHECO, to practice nursing in the State of Texas be, and the same is/are, hereby SUSPENDED IMMEDIATELY in accordance with Section 301.455, TEXAS OCCUPATIONS CODE.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a probable cause hearing be conducted in accordance with Section 301.455(c) not later than seventeen (17) days following the date of the entry of this order, and a final hearing on the matter be conducted in accordance with 301.455(d) not later than the 61st day following the date of the entry of this order.

Additionally, staff will seek to impose on Respondent the administrative costs of the proceeding pursuant to Section 301.461, Texas Occupations Code. The cost of proceedings shall include, but is not limited to, the cost paid by the Board to the State Office of Administrative Hearings and the Office of the Attorney General or other Board counsel for legal and investigative services, the cost of a court reporter and witnesses, reproduction of records, Board staff time, travel, and expenses. These shall be in an amount of at least one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1200.00).
