On this day the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Board

considered the matter of DOROTHY JEANETTE WILSON, Vocational Nurse License Number

138123, hereinafter referred to as Respondent.

Information received by the Board produced evidence that Respondent may be subject

to discipline pursuant to Section 301.452(b)(10)&(13), Texas Occupations Code. Respondent

waived notice and hearing and agreed to the entry of this Order approved by Katherine A. Thomas,

MN, RN, FAAN, Executive Director, on March 23, 2015.

FINDING\$ OF FACT

- 1. Prior to the institution of Agency proceedings, notice of the matters specified below in these Findings of Fact was served on Respondent and Respondent was given an opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license(s).
- 2. Respondent waived notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Order.
- 3. Respondent's license to practice as a vocational nurse in the State of Texas is in current status.
- 4. Respondent received a Certificate in Vocational Nursing from Lewis A. Wilson School of Vocational Nursing, Huntington Station, New York on June 1, 1980. Respondent was licensed to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas on November 25, 1992.
- 5. Respondent's nursing employment history includes:

- 6. At the time of the initial incident, Respondent was employed as a Licensed Vocational Nurse with Red Oak Health and Rehabilitation, Red Oak, Texas, and had been in that position for two (2) months.
- 7. On or about June 1, 2013 through June 30, 2013, while employed as a Licensed Vocational Nurse with Red Oak Health and Rehabilitation, Red Oak, Texas, and assigned to work weekend shifts only, Respondent failed to clarify an order for Patient J.M. and incorrectly administered tube feedings to the patient. Respondent administered Diabetisource AC at 65cc/ml for one (1) hour instead of Diabetisource AC at 65cc/hr for twenty-three (23) hours as ordered and documented on the Medication Administration Record as though the correct amount was given. Respondent's conduct exposed the patient unnecessarily to risk of harm from inadequate nutrition which may have contributed to the patient's significant weight loss and resulted in an inaccurate medical record.
- 8. In response to Finding of Fact Number Seven (7), Respondent states the patient was new to her when she came on duty. The original order was difficult to read. Respondent states she questioned the order herself but that she should have clarified it with a supervisor.
- 9. Formal Charges were filed on February 9, 2015.
- 10. Formal Charges were mailed to Respondent on February 10, 2015.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451-301.555, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Notice was served in accordance with law.

- 3. The evidence received is sufficient to prove violation(s) of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE \S 217.11(1)(A),(1)(B),(1)(C),(1)(D),(1)(N)&(2)(A) and 217.12(1)(A),(1)(B),(1)(C)&(4).
- 4. The evidence received is sufficient cause pursuant to Section 301.452(b)(10)&(13), Texas Occupations Code, to take disciplinary action against Vocational Nurse License Number 138123, heretofore issued to DOROTHY JEANETTE WILSON.
- 5. Pursuant to Section 301.463(d), Texas Occupations Code, this Agreed Order is a settlement agreement under Rule 408, Texas Rules of Evidence, in civil or criminal litigation.

TERMS OF ORDER

I. SANCTION AND APPLICABILITY

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED and ORDERED that RESPONDENT SHALL receive the sanction of **WARNING WITH STIPULATIONS** and Respondent's license(s) shall be placed in **INACTIVE** status.

Should RESPONDENT decide in the future to reactivate his/her license(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas, RESPONDENT SHALL be required to satisfy all then existing requirements for reactivation and RESPONDENT'S reactivated license(s) SHALL BE subject to, at a minimum, the remedial education courses, work restrictions, supervised practice, and employer reporting which would have been requirements of this Order had Respondent not chosen to inactivate his/her nursing license(s).

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RESPONDENT'S CERTIFICATION

I understand that I have the right to legal counsel prior to signing this Agreed Order. I waive representation by counsel. I have reviewed this Order. I neither admit nor deny the violation(s) alleged herein. By my signature on this Order, I agree to the entry of this Order, and any conditions of said Order, to avoid further disciplinary action in this matter. I waive judicial review of this Order. I understand that when this Order becomes final and the terms of this Order become effective, a copy will be mailed to me. I understand that if I fail to comply with all terms and conditions of this Order, I will be subject to investigation and disciplinary sanction, including possible revocation of my license(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas, as a consequence of my noncompliance. I further understand that, should I decide in the future to reactivate my license(s), I will be required to satisfy, at a minimum, the additional requirements that would have been part of this Order had the license(s) not been placed in inactive status, as stated herein, as well as all then existing requirements for reactivation.
