AGREED BOARD ORDER

On this day came on to be considered by the Board of Vocational Nurse Examiner the matter of RAUL V. CARDENAS, an Applicant for Licensure by Examination, hereinafter called Respondent.

By letter, the Board of Vocational Nurse Examiners sent preliminary notice to Respondent of its intent to take disciplinary action with respect to said license held by Respondent as a result of a complaint and subsequent investigation. Said investigation produced evidence indicating that Respondent has been convicted of a crime of the grade of felony or a crime of a lesser grade which involves moral turpitude, in violation of Article 4528c, Section 10 (a) (3), Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, in the following manner:

On or about February 21, 1986, Respondent was convicted for the misdemeanor offense of Resisting Arrest or Search in the County Court at Law No. 4, Bexar County, Texas, Cause No. 360967.

By Respondent's signature on this Order, Respondent neither admits nor denies the truth of the matters previously set out in this Order with respect to the above mentioned investigation.

By his signature on this order RAUL V. CARDENAS does hereby waive the right to Notice of a Formal Hearing, and a Formal Hearing before the Board of Vocational Nurse Examiners, and to judicial review of this disciplinary action. Notice of this disciplinary action will appear in the Board's newsletter sent to Texas employers.

ORDER OF THE BOARD

THEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, The Board of Vocational Nurse Examiners does hereby order that RAUL V. CARDENAS be allowed to write the examination for licensure as a vocational nurse in the State of Texas. In the event that Respondent passes said examination, he will be issued a license. Said license will be suspended, suspension stayed, and placed on probation for one (1) year. It is further stipulated that upon gaining employment in the nursing field, Respondent will cause his nursing employer to submit satisfactory quarterly reports to the Board Office for the term of probation.

Furthermore if the place of employment or respondent's address or telephone number changes, the Board is to be notified immediately.

It is also ordered that RAUL V. CARDENAS shall comply with all the provisions of Article 4528c, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas.

This Agreed Order shall not be effective or take effect and become enforceable until endorsed by a majority of the Board (present and voting), at its next regularly called session.
