ORDER MODIFICATION

Therefore, Petitioner is required to comply with and complete all of the requirements of the February 9, 2016, Agreed Order, except that Stipulation Number Five (V), subsections C, D and E, are modified as follows:

C. For the first year [four (4) quarters] of employment as a Nurse under this Order, RESPONDENT SHALL be directly supervised by a physician, a Registered Nurse or a Licensed PETITIONER is responsible for completing all remaining requirements of the February 9, 2016, Agreed Order as written.
