ORDER GRANTING PETITIONER’S REQUEST FOR EXCEPTION


On this day, the Executive Director, on behalf of the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the “Board”, considered Petitioner’s Request for Exception filed in the above-styled matter. An Agreed Order of the Board was entered on April 21, 2016, for TAMMI SHIRELL SCOTT, Vocational Nurse License Number 214903. Petitioner filed a Request for Exception to the Agreed Order on July 27, 2016. After review and due consideration of the Petitioner’s request, and pursuant to 22 Tex. Admin. Code §211.7(h), the Executive Director of the Board **GRANTS** Petitioner’s Request for Exception.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Petitioner is required to comply with and complete all of the requirements of the April 21, 2016, Agreed Order, except that Stipulation Number Five (V); subsection C is modified as follows:

C. **Indirect Supervision:** RESPONDENT SHALL be supervised by a Registered Nurse, if licensed as a Registered Nurse, or by a Licensed Vocational Nurse or a Registered Nurse, if licensed as a Licensed Vocational Nurse, **who is on the premises**. The supervising nurse is not required to be on the same unit or ward as RESPONDENT, but should be on the facility grounds and readily available to provide assistance and intervention if necessary. The supervising nurse shall a minimum of two (2) years experience in the same or similar setting to which the Respondent is currently working. RESPONDENT SHALL work only regularly assigned, identified and predetermined unit(s). RESPONDENT SHALL NOT be employed by a nurse registry, temporary nurse employment agency, hospice, or home health agency, with the exception that Petitioner may work under a staffing contract for facility or hospice services so long as the contract spans a period of three (3) months at one (1) facility. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT be self-employed or contract for services. Multiple employers is prohibited.

All other terms and conditions of the July 27, 2016, Agreed Order remain unchanged and
Petitioner is responsible for complying with those terms.
