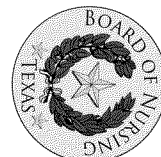

ORDER OF MODIFICATION

A public meeting of the Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee of the Board hereinafter referred to as the Committee, was held on March 21, 2017, at 333 Guadalupe, Tower Suite 460, Austin, Texas, to consider the Petition for Exception and supporting documents filed by BETTYE ANN WILLIAMS, hereinafter referred to as PETITIONER.

PETITIONER appeared in person.

Board Members in attendance were: Patti Clapp, BA; Kathy Shipp, MSN, RN, FNP; and Allison Porter-Edwards, DrPH, MS, RN. Staff present were: Katherine A. Thomas, MN, RN, FAAN, Executive Director; James W. Johnston, General Counsel; Anthony L. Diggs, Director, Enforcement Division; John DeLaRosa, Program Specialist; Kathy Hoffman, Legal Assistant Supervisor; Krystal Mendoza, Legal Assistant; and Diane E. Burell, Compliance Supervisor.

After review and due consideration of the filed Petition, the Committee voted to modify the Reinstatement Agreed Order entered on August 19, 2014. Therefore, Petitioner is required to comply with and complete all of the requirements of the August 19, 2014, Reinstatement Agreed Order, except that Stipulation Numbers Ten (10) and Eleven (11) of that Order, are substituted with the following:

(10) PETITIONER SHALL CAUSE each employer to immediately submit any and all incident, counseling, variance, unusual occurrence, and medication or other error reports involving PETITIONER, as well as documentation of any internal investigations regarding action by PETITIONER, to the attention of Monitoring at the Board's office.

(11) PETITIONER SHALL CAUSE each employer to submit, on forms provided to the PETITIONER by the Board, periodic reports as to PETITIONER's capability to practice nursing. These reports shall be completed by the employer and submitted to the office of the Board at the end of each three (3) month period for two (2) years of employment as a nurse.

PETITIONER is responsible for completing all remaining requirements of the August 19, 2014, Reinstatement Agreed Order as written.
