We have received information you were physically incarcerated in the Institutional Division of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice beginning approximately October 16, 2018, based on your conviction of CONSPIRACY TO COMMIT HEALTH CARE FRAUD & HEALTH CARE FRAUD AND AIDING AND ABETTING, Felony offenses, in the United States District Court, Northern District of Texas Dallas Division, under Cause No. 3:15-CR-00164-B(5).

Therefore, pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Chapter 53.021(b), Permanent Registered Nurse License Number 763324, and Permanent Vocational Nurse License Number 200057 were revoked, by operation of law, on October 16, 2018, the date that your incarceration commenced.

You are entitled to a formal Complaint, Notice of Hearing, and a hearing in which you may present evidence to show that you are not physically incarcerated or have not been physically incarcerated due to your felony conviction(s) or felony probation revocation. In the event you are not physically incarcerated or have not been physically incarcerated, your written request for a hearing before the State Office of Administrative Hearings must be received in this office within twenty (20) days of receipt of this letter.

Please be advised that you may not practice as a nurse or engage in any activities that require a license issued by this Board. Should you desire to return to the practice of nursing in Texas, you may contact our office to request a reinstatement petition. However, you will not be eligible for reinstatement until: at least one (1) year has elapsed from the effective date of your revocation, and you are released from imprisonment. Any reinstatement will then be subject to the regulations in effect at that time.
