IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Petitioner is required to comply with and complete all of the requirements of the June 12, 2018, Agreed Order, except that Stipulation(s) Number Five (5), Subsections D, E and F is/are substituted with the following:

D and E. Incident Reporting: While under the remaining terms of this Order, RESPONDENT SHALL CAUSE each employer to immediately submit any and all incident,

counseling, variance, unusual occurrence, and medication or other error reports involving RESPONDENT, as well as documentation of any internal investigations regarding action by RESPONDENT, to the attention of Monitoring at the Board's office.

F. Nursing Performance Evaluations: While under the remaining terms of this Order, RESPONDENT SHALL CAUSE each employer to submit, on forms provided to the RESPONDENT by the Board, periodic reports as to RESPONDENT's capability to practice nursing. These reports shall be completed by the employer and submitted to the office of the Board at the end of each three (3) month quarterly period for the duration of the Order.

All other terms and conditions of the June 12, 2018, Agreed Order remain unchanged and Petitioner is responsible for complying with those terms as written.
