Dear Mr. Rodriguez:

We have received information you were physically incarcerated in the Federal Prison Camp, Seagoville, Texas, beginning approximately May 6, 2019, based upon your conviction of DISTRIBUTION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE, a Felony offense, in the United States District Court, Northern District of Texas, Dallas Division, under Case No. 3:16-CR-00479-N(3).

Therefore, pursuant to the Texas Occupations Code, Chapter 53.021(b), permanent certificate number(s) AP117756, RX9204, RN522482 and LVN105295 were revoked, by operation of law, on May 6, 2019, the date that your incarceration commenced.

You are entitled to a formal Complaint, Notice of Hearing, and a hearing in which you may present evidence to show that you are not physically incarcerated or have not been physically incarcerated due to your felony conviction(s) or felony probation revocation. You are also entitled to representation by an attorney if you desire. In the event you are not physically incarcerated or have not been physically incarcerated, your written request for a hearing before the State Office of Administrative Hearings must be received in this office within twenty (20) days of receipt of this letter.

Please be advised that you may not practice as a clinical nurse specialist, registered nurse and/or licensed vocational nurse or engage in any activities that require a license issued by this Board. Should you desire to return to the practice of nursing in Texas, you may contact our office to request a reinstatement petition. However, you will not be eligible for reinstatement until at least one (1) year has elapsed from the effective date your revocation and you are released from imprisonment. Any reinstatement will then be subject to the regulations in effect at that time.
