ORDER OF THE BOARD

On this day the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Board, considered the matter of ROGELIO LULE, Registered Nurse License Number 849278, hereinafter referred to as Respondent.

This action was taken in accordance with Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code.

Respondent waived notice and hearing and agreed to the entry of this Order.

The Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent's license to practice as a professional nurse in the State of Texas is in current status.
2. Respondent waived notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Order.
3. Respondent received an Associate Degree in Nursing from Wharton County Junior College, Wharton, Texas, on December 13, 2013. Respondent was licensed to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas on January 21, 2014.
4. Respondent's nursing employment history includes:

1/2014 – 01/2015	Unknown	
02/2015 – Unknown	Floor Nurse	Citizens Medical Center Victoria, Texas

5. On July 3, 2019, Respondent entered a plea of Guilty to INJURY TO A CHILD (3rd Degree felony offense committed on March 22, 2016), in the 130th District Court, Matagorda County, Texas, under Cause No. 16-369. As a result of the plea, the proceedings against Respondent were deferred without entering an adjudication of guilt, and Respondent was placed on probation for a period of ten (10) years. Additionally, Respondent was ordered to surrender his nursing license during the term of his supervision.
6. On July 10, 2019, the Board received a notarized statement from Respondent voluntarily surrendering the right to practice nursing in Texas. A copy of Respondent's statement, dated July 10, 2019, is attached and incorporated herein by reference as part of this Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451 - 301.555, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
3. The evidence received is sufficient to prove violation(s) of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12 (6)(C).
3. The evidence received is sufficient cause pursuant to Section 301.452(b)(3) and Section 301.4535, Texas Occupations Code, to take disciplinary action against Registered Nurse License Number 849278, heretofore issued to ROGELIO LULE, including revocation of Respondent's license(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas.
4. Under Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code, the Board has the authority to accept the voluntary surrender of a license.
5. Under Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, as amended, the Board may impose conditions for reinstatement of licensure.
6. Any subsequent reinstatement of this license will be controlled by Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §213.26-.29, and any amendments thereof in effect at the time of the reinstatement.

TERMS OF ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of Registered Nurse License Number 849278 is accepted by the Texas Board of Nursing. In connection with this acceptance, the Board imposes the following conditions:

1. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT practice professional/registered nursing, use the title "registered nurse" or the abbreviation "RN" or wear any insignia identifying himself as a registered nurse or use any designation which, directly or indirectly, would lead any person to believe that RESPONDENT is a registered nurse during the period in which the license is surrendered.
2. Pursuant to Tex. Occ. Code section 301.4535(c), RESPONDENT SHALL NOT petition for reinstatement of licensure until at least five (5) years from the date the Respondent successfully completes and is dismissed from community supervision or parole has elapsed.
3. Upon petitioning for reinstatement, RESPONDENT SHALL satisfy all then existing requirements for relicensure.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

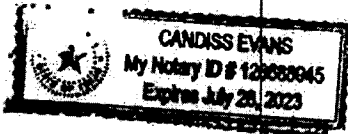
