ORDER GRANTING MODIFICATION

On this day, the Executive Director, on behalf of the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Board, considered the Petition for Exception and supporting documents filed by STACEY ELIZABETH JOHNSON, Registered Nurse License Number 753394, hereinafter referred to as PETITIONER. An Agreed Order of the Board was entered on January 21, 2016. Petitioner filed a Request for Exception to the Agreed Order on April 29, 2019.


After review and due consideration of Petitioner's request, pursuant to 22 Tex. Admin. Code §211.7(h), the Executive Director of the Board **GRANTS MODIFICATION** of the January 21, 2016, Agreed Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Petitioner is required to comply with and complete all of the requirements of the January 21, 2016, Agreed Order, except that Stipulation(s) Number Five (5), Subsection D and E are substituted with the following:

- D. No Night, or Rotating Shifts, Overtime, or On-Call:** For the first year [four (4) quarters] of employment as a Nurse under this Order, PETITIONER SHALL NOT practice as a nurse on the night shift, **with the exception of Petitioner's employment on the night shift with Texas Health Harris Methodist Southwest, Fort Worth, Texas**, rotate shifts, work overtime, accept on-call assignments, or be used for coverage on any unit other than the identified, predetermined unit(s) to which Petitioner is regularly assigned.

- E. **No Critical Care:** For the first year [four (4) quarters] of employment as a Nurse under this Order, PETITIONER SHALL NOT practice as a nurse in any critical care area, **with the exception of Petitioner's employment in the neonatal unit with Texas Health Harris Methodist Southwest, Fort Worth, Texas.** Critical care areas include, but are not limited to, intensive care units, emergency rooms, operating rooms, telemetry units, recovery rooms, and labor and delivery units.
