## ORDER GRANTING MODIFICATION

An Agreed Order of the Board was entered on October 25, 2018, for COURTNEY ANN MITCHELL, Vocational Nurse License Number 207937, hereinafter referred to as PETITIONER. PETITIONER filed a Request for Exception to the Agreed Order on January 2, 2020.

A public meeting of the Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee of the Board, hereinafter referred to as the Committee, was held on February 11, 2020, at 333 Guadalupe Street, Tower 3, Suite 460, Austin, Texas, to consider the Petition for Exception and supporting documents filed by PETITIONER.

PETITIONER appeared in person.

Board Members in attendance were: David Saucedo, II; Diana Flores, MN, RN; and Allison Porter-Edwards, DrPH, MS, RN, CNE.

After review and due consideration of the file petition, the Committee voted to **GRANT MODIFICATION** of the October 25, 2018, Agreed Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Petitioner is required to comply with and complete all of the requirements of the October 25, 2018, Agreed Order, except that the Employment Requirements, Subsections C and D are substituted with the following requirements for the remainder of the Order:

C. Incident Reporting: While under the remaining terms of this Order,

RESPONDENT SHALL CAUSE each employer to immediately submit any and all incident,

counseling, variance, unusual occurrence, and medication or other error reports involving

RESPONDENT, as well as documentation of any internal investigations regarding action by

RESPONDENT, to the attention of Monitoring at the Board's office.

D. Nursing Performance Evaluations: While under the remaining terms of this

Order, RESPONDENT SHALL CAUSE each employer to submit, on forms provided to the

RESPONDENT by the Board, periodic reports as to RESPONDENT's capability to practice

nursing. These reports shall be completed by the employer and submitted to the office of the Board

at the end of each three (3) month quarterly period for the remaining period of the October 25,

2018, Order.

All other terms and conditions of the October 25, 2018, Agreed Order remain

unchanged and Petitioner is responsible for complying with those terms as written.
