ORDER GRANTING MODIFICATION

C. Incident Reporting: While under the remaining terms of this Order,

PETITIONER SHALL CAUSE each employer to immediately submit any and all incident,

counseling, variance, unusual occurrence, and medication or other error reports involving

PETITIONER, as well as documentation of any internal investigations regarding action by

PETITIONER, to the attention of Monitoring at the Board's office.

D. Nursing Performance Evaluations: While under the remaining terms of this

Order, PETITIONER SHALL CAUSE each employer to submit, on forms provided to the

PETITIONER by the Board, periodic reports as to PETITIONER's capability to practice nursing.

These reports shall be completed by the employer and submitted to the office of the Board at the

end of each three (3) month quarterly period for the remaining period of the June 14, 2014, Order.

All other terms and conditions of the June 14, 2014, Agreed Order remain

unchanged and Petitioner is responsible for complying with those terms as written.
