NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER OF THE BOARD

A Default Revocation Order was entered for DEREKIA REMEIKO ANDERSON or February 11, 2020. The Order, however, contained the incorrect date on page 1 of the Order. Upon notice and hearing, administrative agencies, like the Courts, have the power to enter nunc pro tunc orders where it can be seen by reference to a record that what was intended to be entered, but was omitted by inadvertence or mistake, can be corrected upon satisfactory proof of its rendition provided that no intervening rights will be prejudiced. *Railroad Comm'n v. McClain*, 356 S.W.2d 330, 334 (Tex. App.--Austin 1962, no writ) (citing *Frankfort Ky. Nat. Gas Co. v. City of Frankfort*, 276 Ky. 199, 123 S.W.2d 270, 272).

The Executive Director, as agent of the Texas Board of Nursing, after review and due consideration of the record and the facts therein submits and enters the corrected Default Revocation Order. Respondent received due process regarding her license; therefore, her rights have not been prejudiced.

FORMAL CHARGES

This is a disciplinary proceeding under Section 301.452(b), Texas Occupations Code. Respondent, DEREZIA REMEIKO ANDERSON, is a Registered Nurse holding license number 830013 which is in current status at the time of this pleading.

Written notice of the facts and conduct alleged to warrant adverse licensure action was sent to Respondent at Respondent's address of record and Respondent was given opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license prior to commencement of this proceeding.

CHARGE I.

On or about April 8, 2018, while employed as a Registered Nurse with Renew Home Health, Fort Worth, Texas, and assigned to provide skilled nursing to Patient FW105-01, Respondent submitted nursing notes for visits that were either not conducted, or conducted at different times than those documented as having been worked. Respondent's conduct resulted in an inaccurate medical record and was likely to defraud and deceive the facility of money paid to the Respondent for hours not actually worked. In addition, Respondent's conduct was likely to injure the patient in that subsequent care givers would rely on her documentation for further care.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(13), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.11(1)(A),(1)(B),(1)(D)&(3).

NOTICE IS GIVEN that staff will present evidence in support of the recommended disposition of up to, and including, revocation of Respondent's license(s) and/or privilege(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas pursuant to the Nursing Practice Act, Chapter 301, Texas Occupations Code and the Board's rules, 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 213.27 - 213.33.



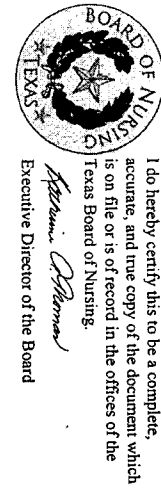

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
