DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

ORDER OF THE BOARD

TO: Randall Parish 208 Shore Line Wichita Falls, TX 76308

During open meeting held in Austin, Texas, on June 9, 2020, the Texas Board of Nursing Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee (hereinafter "Committee") heard the above-styled case, based on the failure of the Respondent to appear as required by 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE Ch. 213.

The Committee finds that notice of the facts or conduct alleged to warrant disciplinary action has been provided to Respondent in accordance with Texas Government Code § 2001.054(c) and Respondent has been given an opportunity to show compliance with all the requirements of the Nursing Practice Act, Chapter 301 of the Texas Occupations Code, for retention of Respondent's license(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

The Committee finds that the Formal Charges were properly initiated and filed in accordance with section 301.458, Texas Occupations Code.

The Committee finds that after proper and timely Notice regarding the violations alleged in the Formal Charges was given to Respondent in this matter, Respondent has failed to appear in accordance with 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE Ch. 213.

The Committee finds that the Board is authorized to enter a default order pursuant to Texas Government Code § 2001.056.

The Committee, after review and due consideration, adopts the proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law as stated in the Formal Charges which are attached hereto and incorporated by

reference for all purposes and the Staff's recommended sanction of revocation by default. This Order will be properly served on all parties and all parties will be given an opportunity to file a motion for rehearing [22 Tex. ADMIN. Code § 213.16(j)]. All parties have a right to judicial review of this Order.

All proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law filed by any party not specifically adopted herein are hereby denied.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Permanent Registered Nurse License Number 717509, previously issued to RANDALL KEITH PARISH to practice nursing in the State of Texas be, and the same is/are hereby, REVOKED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

FORMAL CHARGES

This is a disciplinary proceeding under Section 301.452(b), Texas Occupations Code. Respondent, RANDALL KEITH PARISH, is a Registered Nurse holding license number 717509 which is in current status at the time of this pleading.

Written notice of the facts and conduct alleged to warrant adverse licensure action was sent to Respondent at Respondent's address of record and Respondent was given opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license prior to commencement of this proceeding.

CHARGE I.

On or about May 11, 2019, through May 12, 2019, while employed as a Registered Nurse with North Texas State Hospital, Wichita Falls, Texas, Respondent failed to appropriately assess and document Patient Identification Number 321177's ongoing vital signs and neurological status, after the patient fell and sustained a raised bump to the back of her head. The patient had a history of brain surgery, prior stroke, and was prescribed Plavix, a blood thinner, as treatment for her medical conditions. Respondent's conduct was likely to injure the patient from lack of nursing interventions for risk of head injury in a neurologically impaired patient, and also resulted in an incomplete medical record.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10)&(13), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §217. 11(1)(A),(1)(B),(1)(D),(1)(M)&(3)(A), and 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §217.12 (1)(A),(1)(B)&(4).

CHARGE II.

On or about May 13, 2019, while employed as a Registered Nurse with North Texas State Hospital, Wichita Falls, Texas, Respondent failed to assess Patient Identification Number 321177, a neurologically impaired patient, when the patient experienced elevated heart rate and respirations while sleeping, after sustaining a raised bump to the head over the weekend. Instead, he let the patient continue sleeping. Subsequently, at approximately 08:35 AM, the patient experienced respirations of 42, was unresponsive to pain stimuli, was transferred to the hospital and received emergent surgery for a brain hemorrhage. Respondent's conduct resulted in an incomplete medical record and may have contributed to the delay in the onset of medical treatment for brain hemorrhage.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10)&(13), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217. 11(1)(A),(1)(B),(1)(M)&(3)(A), and 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217. 12(1)(A),(1)(B)&(4).

CHARGE III.

On or about May 13, 2019, while employed as a Registered Nurse with North Texas State Hospital, Wichita Falls, Texas, Respondent failed to notify the physician, and failed to document the patient's vital signs and neurological status, when Patient Identification Number 321177, a neurologically impaired patient, experienced elevated heart rate and respirations while sleeping, after sustaining a raised bump to the head over the weekend. Instead, he let the patient continue sleeping. Subsequently, at approximately 08:35 AM, the patient experienced respirations of 42, was unresponsive to pain stimuli, was transferred to the hospital and received emergent surgery for a brain hemorrhage. Respondent's conduct resulted in an incomplete medical record and may have contributed to the delay in the onset of medical treatment for brain hemorrhage.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10)&(13), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217. 11(1)(A),(1)(B),(1)(D),(1)(P)&(3)(A), and 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12 (1)(A),(1)(B),(1)(C)&(4).

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NOTICE IS GIVEN that staff will present evidence in support of the recommended disposition of up to, and including, revocation of Respondent's license(s) and/or privilege(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas pursuant to the Nursing Practice Act, Chapter 301, Texas Occupations Code and the Board's rules, 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 213.27 - 213.33.
