On this day, the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Board, considered the matter of HSIAOHSUAN LI, Registered Nurse License Number 804462, hereinafter referred to as Respondent.

Information received by the Board produced evidence that Respondent may be subject to discipline pursuant to Section 301.452(b)(10) and (13) of the Texas Occupations Code.

After filing of Formal Charges, Respondent waived notice and hearing and agreed to the entry of this Agreed Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- Prior to the institution of Agency proceedings, notice of the matters specified below in these Findings of Fact was served on Respondent and Respondent was given an opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license.
- 2. Respondent waived notice and hearing and agreed to the entry of this Agreed Order.
- 3. Respondent's license to practice as a professional nurse in the State of Texas is in current status.
- Respondent received a Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing from Baylor University.
 Dallas, Texas on May 13, 2011. Respondent was licensed to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas on June 30, 2011.
- 5. Respondent's nursing employment history includes:

6. At the time of the incident, Respondent was employed as a Registered Nurse with Texas Health Presbyterian Denton, Denton, Texas, and had been in that position for five (5) years and one (1) month.

- 7. On or about October 15, 2019, while employed as a Registered Nurse with Texas Health Presbyterian Denton, Denton, Texas, Respondent allegedly misappropriated property of a patient leading to Respondent's arrest.
- 8. In response to Finding of Fact Number Seven (7). Respondent neither admits nor denies the allegation.
- 9. Respondent by his signature expresses his desire to voluntary surrender his nursing license.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451-301.555, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
- 3. The evidence received is sufficient to prove violation(s) of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE \$217.11(l)(J) and 22 TEX. ADMJN. CODE \$217.12(6)(D) and (6)(G).
- 4. The evidence received is sufficient cause pursuant to Section 301.452(b)(l0) and (13) of the Texas Occupations Code, to take disciplinary action against Registered Nurse License Number 804462, heretofore issued to HSIAOHSUAN LI.
- 5. Pursuant to Section 301.463(d). Texas Occupations Code, this Agreed Order is a settlement agreement under Rule 408. Texas Rules of Evidence; in civil or criminal litigation.

TERMS OF ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE. IT IS AGREED and ORDERED that the VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of Registered Nurse License Number 804462 is accepted by the Texas

Board of Nursing. In connection with this acceptance, the Board imposes the following conditions:

RESPONDENT SHALL NOT practice professional/registered nursing, use the title "registered nurse" or the abbreviation "RN" or wear any insignia identifying himself as a registered nurse or use any designation which, directly or indirectly, would lead any person to believe that RESPONDENT is a registered nurse during the period in which the license is surrendered.

- 1. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT petition for reinstatement of licensure until at least one (1) year has elapsed from the date of this Order.
- 2. Upon petitioning for reinstatement, RESPONDENT SHALL satisfy all the existing requirements for relicensure.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

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RESPONDENT'S CERTIFICATION

I understand that I have the right to legal counsel prior to signing this Order. I have reviewed this Order. I neither admit nor deny the violation(s) alleged herein. By my signature on this Order, I agree to the entry of this Order, and any conditions of said Order, to avoid further disciplinary action in this matter. I waive judicial review of this Order. I understand that this Order becomes effective upon acceptance by the Executive Director on behalf of the Texas Board of Nursing and a copy will be mailed to me. I understand that if I fail to comply with all terms and conditions of this Order, I will be subject to investigation and disciplinary sanction, including possible revocation of my license(s) and/or privileges to practice nursing in the State of Texas, as a consequence of my noncompliance.
