We previously provided you with notice that an investigation was being initiated into the following alleged violations of the Nursing Practice Act and/or the Board's Rules and Regulations Relating to Nurse Education, Licensure, and Practice:

- On or about September 9, 2011, you entered a plea of Guilty to and were convicted of MANUFACTURE OR DELIVERY OF SUBSTANCE IN PENALTY GROUP ONE (1) WITH AN AGGREGATE WEIGHT OF FOUR (4) GRAMS OR MORE BUT LESS THAN TWO HUNDRED (200) GRAMS, a First (1st) Degree Felony offense committed on June 17, 2011, in the Thirteenth (13th) District Court Corsicana, under Cause Number 33787. As a result of the conviction, you were placed on probation for a period of eight (8) years. Additionally, you were ordered to pay a fine of one thousand (1000) dollars, and court costs of seven hundred and forty-seven (747) dollars.
- On or about January 13, 2012, you entered a plea of No Contest or Nolo Contendere to and were convicted of MANUFACTURE OR DELIVERY OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE IN PENALTY GROUP ONE (1) WITH AN AGGREGATE WEIGHT OF FOUR (4) GRAMS OR MORE BUT LESS THAN TWO HUNDRED (200) GRAMS, a First (1st) Degree Felony committed on February 16, 2011, in the Sixty-sixth (66) District Court Hillsboro, under Cause Number 36853. As a result of the conviction, you were sentenced to confinement for a period of ten (10) years; however, imposition of the sentence of confinement was suspended and you were placed on probation for a period of ten (10) years. Additionally, you were ordered to pay a fine of one thousand (1000) dollars, along with court costs of three-hundred and seventy-four (374) dollars.
- On or about October 18, 2013, you entered a plea of Guilty to and were convicted of UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF FIREARM BY A FELON, a Third (3rd) Degree Felony offense committed on July 21, 2013, in the Fortieth (40) District Court Waxahachie, under Cause Number 38344CR. As a result of the conviction, you were sentenced to confinement for a period of five (5) years. Additionally, you were ordered to pay the court costs of two-hundred and seventy-nine (279) dollars.
- On or about October 18, 2013, you entered a plea of Guilty to and were convicted of POSSESSION OF SUBSTANCE IN PENALTY GROUP ONE (1) AGGREGATE WEIGHT IS LESS THAN ONE (1) GRAM, a State Jail Felony offense committed on July 21, 2013, in the Fortieth (40) District Court Waxahachie, under Cause Number 38344CR. As a result of the conviction, you were sentenced to confinement for a period of two hundred and seventy (270) days. Additionally, you were ordered to pay restitution of one-hundred and forty (140) dollars, along with court costs of eight-hundred and four (804) dollars.
- On or about November 25, 2013, your probation granted under Cause Number 33787 was revoked in the Thirteenth (13th) District Court Corsicana Texas. As a result, you were adjudged Guilty of MANUFACTURE OR DELIVERY OF SUBSTANCE IN PENALTY GROUP ONE (1) WITH AN AGGREGATE WEIGHT OF FOUR (4) GRAMS OR MORE BUT LESS THAN TWO HUNDRED (200) GRAMS, a First (1st) Degree Felony offense committed on June 17, 2011, and sentenced to confinement in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice Huntsville for a period of five (5) years.

- On or about December 11, 2013, your probation granted under Cause Number 36853 was revoked in the Sixty-sixth (66) District Court Hillsboro Texas. As a result, you were adjudged Guilty of MANUFACTURE OR DELIVERY OF SUBSTANCE IN PENALTY GROUP ONE WITH AN AGGREGATE WEIGHT OF FOUR (4) GRAMS OR MORE BUT LESS THAN TWO HUNDRED (200) GRAMS, a First (1st) Degree Felony offense committed on February 16, 2011, and sentenced to confinement in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice Huntsville for a period of seven (7) years.

We have received information confirming you were physically incarcerated in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice Huntsville beginning approximately February 19, 2014, based on your conviction of MANUFACTURE OR DELIVERY OF SUBSTANCE IN PENALTY GROUP ONE WITH AN AGGREGATE WEIGHT OF FOUR (4) GRAMS OR MORE BUT LESS THAN TWO HUNDRED (200) GRAMS, a First (1st) Degree Felony offense, in the Sixty-sixth (66) District Court Hillsboro Texas, under Cause No. 36853.


Therefore, pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Chapter 53.021(b), Permanent Vocational Nurse License Number 199833 was revoked, by operation of law, on February 19, 2014, the date that your incarceration commenced.

You are entitled to a formal Complaint, Notice of Hearing, and a hearing in which you may present evidence to show that you are not physically incarcerated or have not been physically incarcerated due to your felony conviction(s) or felony probation revocation. You are also entitled to representation by an attorney if you desire. In the event you are not physically incarcerated or have not been physically incarcerated, your written request for a hearing before the State Office of Administrative Hearings must be received in this office within twenty (20) days of receipt of this letter.

Please be advised that you may not practice as a nurse or engage in any activities that require a license issued by this Board. Should you desire to return to the practice of nursing in Texas, you may contact our office to request a reinstatement petition. However, you will not be eligible for reinstatement until: at least one (1) year has elapsed from the effective date of your revocation, and you are released from imprisonment. Any reinstatement will then be subject to the regulations in effect at that time.
