ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

TO: Ricky Young c/o Bridget Eyler, Attorney At Law 320 Decker Dr., Ste. 100 Irving, TX 75062

A public meeting of the Texas Board of Nursing was held on June 24, 2021 at 333 Guadalupe, Room 3-460, Austin, Texas, in which the Temporary Suspension of Permanent Registered Nurse License Number 765065, issued to RICKY DON YOUNG was considered pursuant to Section 301.455, TEXAS OCCUPATIONS CODE. Staff of the Texas Board of Nursing presented evidence and information concerning the conduct of RICKY DON YOUNG and whether his continued practice as a nurse would constitute a continuing and imminent threat to the public welfare.

After review and due consideration of the evidence and information presented, the Board finds that the following charges are substantiated:

Charge I.

On or about November 25, 2020, and November 26, 2020, while employed as a Registered Nurse with iCare Emergency Center, Fort Worth, Texas, on two separate occasions, Respondent removed Hydromorphone 2mg from the narcotic cabinet, took a needle and syringe, and went directly to the restroom. Furthermore, Respondent failed to make entries in the narcotic log both times that he removed the Hydromorphone vials. Additionally, the two incidents were observed on video surveillance. Respondent's conduct was likely to defraud the facility of the cost of the medication.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE \$217.12(1)(A),(1)(B),(4),(6)(G),(8),(10)(E)&(11)(B).

Charge II.

On or about January 12, 2021, Respondent was referred to the Texas Peer Assistance Program for Nurses (TPAPN) for drug tampering. On April 9, 2021, Respondent completed a TPAPN Psychological Evaluation and was assessed with an opioid use disorder and deemed not safe to practice nursing. Respondent's condition could have affected his ability to recognize subtle signs, symptoms or changes in patients' conditions, and could have affected his ability to make rational, accurate, and appropriate assessments, judgments, and decisions regarding patient care, thereby placing the patients in potential danger.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10)&(12), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(1)(A),(4)&(5).

The Texas Board of Nursing further finds that, given the nature of the charges, the continued practice of nursing by RICKY DON YOUNG constitutes a continuing and imminent threat to public welfare and that the temporary suspension of Permanent Registered Nurse License Number 765065, is justified pursuant to Section 301.455, TEXAS OCCUPATIONS CODE.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Permanent Registered Nurse License Number 765065, issued to RICKY DON YOUNG, to practice nursing in the State of Texas be, and the same is, hereby SUSPENDED IMMEDIATELY in accordance with Section 301.455, TEXAS OCCUPATIONS CODE.

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a probable cause hearing be conducted in accordance with Section 301.455(c) not later than seventeen (17) days following the date of the entry of this order, and a final hearing on the matter be conducted in accordance with 301.455(d) not later than the 61st day following the date of the entry of this order.

FORMAL CHARGES

This is a disciplinary proceeding under Section 301.452(b), Texas Occupations Code. Respondent, RICKY DON YOUNG, is a Registered Nurse holding license number 765065 which is in current status at the time of this pleading.

Written notice of the facts and conduct alleged to warrant adverse licensure action was sent to Respondent at Respondent's address of record and Respondent was given opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license prior to commencement of this proceeding.

CHARGE I.

On or about November 25, 2020, and November 26, 2020, while employed as a Registered Nurse with iCare Emergency Center, Fort Worth, Texas, on two separate occasions, Respondent removed Hydromorphone 2mg from the narcotic cabinet, took a needle and syringe, and went directly to the restroom. NOTICE IS GIVEN that staff will present evidence in support of the recommended disposition of up to, and including, revocation of Respondent's license(s) and/or privilege(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas pursuant to the Nursing Practice Act, Chapter 301, Texas Occupations Code and the Board's rules, 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 213.27 - 213.33.

NOTICE IS GIVEN that, based on the Formal Charges, the Board will rely on adopted policies related to Substance Use Disorders and Other Alcohol and Drug Related Conduct, and on adopted policies related to Behavior Involving Fraud, Theft, and Deception, which can be found under the "Discipline & Complaints; Board Policies & Guidelines" section of the Board's website, www.bon.texas.gov.

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NOTICE IS GIVEN that, based on the Formal Charges, the Board will rely on the Disciplinary Matrix, located at 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §213.33(b), which can be found under the "Discipline & Complaints; Board Policies & Guidelines" section of the Board's website, www.bon.texas.gov.
