On this day the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Board, considered the matter of CHRISTINA LEEANN SCHULTZ, Vocational Nurse License Number 190296, hereinafter referred to as Respondent.

Information received by the Board produced evidence that Respondent may be subject to discipline pursuant to Section 301.452(b)(10)&(13), Texas Occupations Code.

Respondent waived notice and hearing and agreed to the entry of this Agreed Order approved by Katherine A. Thomas, MN, RN, FAAN, Executive Director, on January 29, 2021.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Prior to the institution of Agency proceedings, notice of the matters specified below in these Findings of Fact was served on Respondent and Respondent was given an opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license(s).
2. Respondent waived notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Agreed Order.
3. Respondent's license to practice as a vocational nurse in the State of Texas is in current status.
4. Respondent received a Certificate in Vocational Nursing from Navarro College, Corsicana, Texas, on August 8, 2003. Respondent was licensed to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas on September 16, 2003.
5. Respondent's nursing employment history includes:

9/2003 – 10/2019	Unknown	
10/2019 – 11/2020	Licensed Vocational Nurse	Legacy West Healthcare & Rehab Corsicana, Texas

Respondent's nursing employment history continued:

11/2020 – Present      Unknown

6. At the time of the initial incident, Respondent was employed as a Licensed Vocational Nurse with Legacy West Healthcare and Rehabilitation, Corsicana, Texas, and had been in that position for
7. On or about October 30, 2020, while employed as a Licensed Vocational Nurse with Legacy West Healthcare and Rehabilitation, Corsicana, Texas, Respondent pawned patient C.T.'s 1.5 karat diamond gold/yellow wedding ring valued at nine thousand four hundred ninety-nine dollars and ninety-nine cents (\$9,499.99) at Dallas Gold & Silver Exchange, Grand Prairie, Texas. Respondent was identified as the individual who had pawned the ring. Furthermore, on or about November 5, 2020, Respondent was arrested by the Corsicana Police Department, Corsicana, Texas, for THEFT PROP >=\$2,500 < \$30K, a State Jail felony offense. Respondent's conduct could have caused financial loss to the patient, and resulted in confusion between Respondent's needs and those of the patient. Additionally, Respondent's conduct may have caused delayed distress for the patient, which may not be recognized or felt by the patient until harmful consequences occur.
8. In response to Finding of Fact Number Seven (7), Respondent states she did not steal from this patient. Respondent states her assigned work area in conjunction with this patient's room is not even in the same area, and she rarely would come in contact with this patient. Respondent states she was not the charge nurse for this patient.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451-301.555, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
3. The evidence received is sufficient to prove violation(s) of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.11 (1)(A)&(1)(J) and 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12 (1)(A),(1)(B),(4),(6)(D)&(6)(G).
4. The evidence received is sufficient cause pursuant to Section 301.452(b)(10)&(13), Texas Occupations Code, to take disciplinary action against Vocational Nurse License Number 190296, heretofore issued to CHRISTINA LEEANN SCHULTZ.

5. Pursuant to Section 301.463(d), Texas Occupations Code, this Agreed Order is a settlement agreement under Rule 408, Texas Rules of Evidence, in civil or criminal litigation.

**TERMS OF ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED and ORDERED that the VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of Vocational Nurse License Number 190296 is accepted by the Texas Board of Nursing. In connection with this acceptance, the Board imposes the following conditions:

1. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT practice vocational nursing, use the title "vocational nurse" or the abbreviation "LVN" or wear any insignia identifying herself as a vocational nurse or use any designation which, directly or indirectly, would lead any person to believe that RESPONDENT is a vocational nurse during the period in which the license is surrendered.
2. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT petition for reinstatement of licensure until at least one (1) year has elapsed from the date of this Order.
3. Upon petitioning for reinstatement, RESPONDENT SHALL satisfy all then existing requirements for relicensure.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

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**RESPONDENT'S CERTIFICATION**

I understand that I have the right to legal counsel prior to signing this Order. I waive representation by counsel. I have reviewed this Order. I neither admit nor deny the violation(s) alleged herein. By my signature on this Order, I agree to the entry of this Order, and any conditions of said Order, to avoid further disciplinary action in this matter. I waive judicial review of this Order. I understand that this Order becomes effective upon acceptance by the Executive Director on behalf of the Texas Board of Nursing and a copy will be mailed to me. I understand that if I fail to comply with all terms and conditions of this Order, I will be subject to investigation and disciplinary sanction, including possible revocation of my license(s) and/or privileges to practice nursing in the State of Texas, as a consequence of my noncompliance.
