Also be aware that although the National Council State Boards of Nursing, Inc., and the National Practitioner Data Bank (NPDB) will be notified of your successful completion of the terms of the Deferred Agreed Order, this disciplinary history may remain accessible to other state boards of nursing and certain members of the public through these databases.
