On this day the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Board, considered the matter of SEVERINE BERGERON WHITTIER, Advanced Practice Registered Nurse License Number AP142755, and Registered Nurse License Number 737555, hereinafter referred to as Respondent.

Information received by the Board produced evidence that Respondent may be subject to discipline pursuant to Section 301.452(b)(8), Texas Occupations Code.

Respondent waived notice and hearing and agreed to the entry of this Agreed Order approved by Katherine A. Thomas, MN, RN, FAAN, Executive Director, on October 1, 2021.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Prior to the institution of Agency proceedings, notice of the matters specified below in these Findings of Fact was served on Respondent and Respondent was given an opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license(s).
2. Respondent waived notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Agreed Order.
3. Respondent's license to practice as a professional nurse in the State of Texas is in current status. Respondent's license to practice as an advanced practice registered nurse in the State of Texas with authorization as a Nurse Anesthetist without Prescription Authorization is in current status.
4. Respondent received a Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing from Baylor University, Dallas, Texas, on December 16, 2006. Respondent completed a Nurse Anesthetist Program from Case Western Reserve University, Cleveland, Ohio, on January 15, 2016. Respondent was licensed to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas on January 30, 2007.

Respondent was licensed to practice advanced practice registered nursing in the State of Texas with authorization as a Nurse Anesthetist on August 15, 2019.

5. On or about May 4, 2020; Respondent was issued a Consent Order by the State Education Department of the University of the State of New York, wherein her license to practice as a registered professional nurse in the State of New York was suspended. A copy of the Consent Order dated May 4, 2020, is attached and incorporated by reference as part of this pleading.
6. On or about March 18, 2021, Respondent was issued a Consent Agreement by the Ohio Board of Nursing, Columbus, Ohio, wherein Respondent's license to practice professional nursing was suspended indefinitely. The suspension was stayed and subject to Probationary Terms and Restrictions for a minimum period of two (2) years. A copy of the Consent Agreement dated March 18, 2021, is attached and incorporated by reference as part of this pleading.
7. In response to Finding of Fact Number Five (5), Respondent states her prior substance abuse issues stem from unresolved health issues for which Respondent has since received treatment. Two years before she entered the Consent Order with New York, Respondent states she referred herself to the Texas Peer Assistance Program for Nurses (TPAPN).
8. On or about October 6, 2021, the Texas Board of Nursing was informed by the Texas Peer Assistance Program for Nurses (TPAPN), that Respondent completed the program on or about August 23, 2021.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451-301.555, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
3. The evidence received is sufficient cause pursuant to Section 301.452(b)(8), Texas Occupations Code, to take disciplinary action against Advanced Practice Registered Nurse License Number AP142755, and Registered Nurse License Number 737555, heretofore issued to SEVERINE BERGERON WHITTIER.
4. Pursuant to Section 301.463(d), Texas Occupations Code, this Agreed Order is a settlement agreement under Rule 408, Texas Rules of Evidence, in civil or criminal litigation.

TERMS OF ORDER

I. SANCTION AND APPLICABILITY

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED and ORDERED that RESPONDENT SHALL receive the sanction of **REMEDIAL EDUCATION** in accordance with the terms of this Order.

- A. This Order SHALL apply to any and all future licenses issued to RESPONDENT to practice nursing in the State of Texas.
- B. This Order SHALL be applicable to RESPONDENT'S nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice nursing in the State of Texas.
- C. Until successfully completed, RESPONDENT may not practice nursing in the State of Texas except in accordance with the terms of this Order.
- D. As a result of this Order, RESPONDENT'S license(s) will be designated "single state" as applicable and RESPONDENT may not work outside the State of Texas in another nurse licensure compact party state using a Texas compact license.

II. COMPLIANCE WITH LAW

While under the terms of this Order, RESPONDENT agrees to comply in all respects with the Nursing Practice Act, Texas Occupations Code, §§301.001 *et seq.*, the Rules and Regulations Relating to Nursing Education, Licensure and Practice, 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§211.1 *et seq.*, and this Agreed Order.

III. UNDERSTANDING BOARD ORDERS

Within thirty (30) days of entry of this Order, RESPONDENT must successfully complete the Board's online course, "Understanding Board Orders", which can be accessed on the Board's website from the "Discipline & Complaints" drop-down menu or directly at: <http://www.bon.texas.gov/UnderstandingBoardOrders/index.asp>. Upon successful

completion, RESPONDENT must submit the course verification at the conclusion of the course, which automatically transmits the verification to the Board.

IV. **REMEDIAL EDUCATION COURSE(S)**

In addition to any continuing education requirements the Board may require for licensure renewal, RESPONDENT SHALL successfully complete the following remedial education course(s) **within one (1) year of the effective date of this Order, unless otherwise specifically indicated:**

- A. **A Board-approved course in Texas nursing jurisprudence and ethics** that shall be a minimum of six (6) hours in length. The course's content shall include the Nursing Practice Act, standards of practice, documentation of care, principles of nursing ethics, confidentiality, professional boundaries, and the Board's Disciplinary Sanction Policies regarding: Sexual Misconduct; Fraud, Theft, and Deception; Nurses with Substance Abuse, Misuse, Substance Dependency, or other Substance Use Disorder; and Lying and Falsification. Courses focusing on malpractice issues will not be accepted. Home study and video programs will not be approved.

- B. **The course "Sharpening Critical Thinking Skills,"** a 3.6 contact hour online program provided by the National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN) Learning Extension.

In order to receive credit for completion of this/these course(s), RESPONDENT SHALL CAUSE the instructor to submit a Verification of Course Completion form or SHALL submit the continuing education certificate, as applicable, to the attention of Monitoring at the Board's office. RESPONDENT SHALL first obtain Board approval of any course prior to enrollment if the course is not being offered by a pre-approved provider. *Information about Board-approved courses and Verification of Course Completion forms are available from the Board at www.bon.texas.gov/compliance.*

V. **RESTORATION OF UNENCUMBERED LICENSE(S)**

Upon full compliance with the terms of this Agreed Order, all encumbrances will be removed from RESPONDENT'S license(s) and/or privilege(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas and, subject to meeting all existing eligibility requirements in Texas

Occupations Code Chapter 304, Article III, RESPONDENT may be eligible for nurse licensure compact privileges, if any.

RESPONDENT'S CERTIFICATION

I understand that I have the right to legal counsel prior to signing this Order. I have reviewed this Order. I neither admit nor deny the violation(s) alleged herein. By my signature on this Order, I agree to the entry of this Order, and any conditions of said Order, to avoid further disciplinary action in this matter. I waive judicial review of this Order. I understand that this Order becomes effective upon acceptance by the Executive Director on behalf of the Texas Board of Nursing and a copy will be mailed to me. I understand that if I fail to comply with all terms and conditions of this Order, I will be subject to investigation and disciplinary sanction, including possible revocation of my license(s) and/or privileges to practice nursing in the State of Texas, as a consequence of my noncompliance.





SEVERINE MARIE WHITTIER states:

That on or about March 27, 2017, I was licensed to practice as
a registered professional nurse in the State of New York, having
been issued license number 729819 by the New York State Education
Department.

I am currently registered with the New York State Education
Department to practice as a registered professional nurse in the
State of New York from an address at 2890 Huntington Road, Shaker
Heights, Ohio 44120. My current mailing address is P.O. Box 2233,
Whitney, Texas 76692.

That I have been charged with one (1) specification of
professional misconduct, a copy of which is annexed hereto, made a
part hereof, and marked as Exhibit "A".

SEVERINE MARIE WHITTIER

I admit guilt to the aforesaid one (1) specification of professional misconduct, charging me with committing unprofessional conduct (moral unfitness in the practice of nursing).

I hereby agree to the penalty that my license to practice as a registered professional nurse in the State of New York be suspended indefinitely until, at my expense, I submit a written report from a physician, psychologist, licensed clinical social worker, or nurse practitioner (psychiatric specialty) selected by me and previously approved, in writing, by the New York State Education Department, to the Director, Office of Professional Discipline, New York State Education Department, 1411 Broadway - 10th Floor, New York, New York 10018-3496, in which said physician, psychologist, licensed clinical social worker, or nurse practitioner (psychiatric specialty) shall verify that I am fit to practice as a registered professional nurse in the State of New York. Said suspension shall continue until the Director is satisfied that I am fit to practice, at which time said Director shall notify me of the termination of the suspension of my license and the effective date thereof.

SEVERINE MARIE WHITTIER

I further agree that, upon termination of the suspension of my aforesaid license, I be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years, to commence upon my return to the practice of nursing in the State of New York, under the terms set forth in the exhibit annexed hereto, made a part hereof, and marked as Exhibit "B"; and that I shall be fined five hundred (\$500) dollars, said fine to be paid by certified or bank cashier's check, made payable to the New York State Education Department, to be delivered to the Director, Office of Professional Discipline, 1411 Broadway--Tenth Floor, New York, New York 10018-3496, as aforesaid, within six (6) months after the effective date of the service of the order to be issued in the matter.

I further agree to inform the Director, Office of Professional Discipline, of my return to the practice of nursing in the State of New York, by certified mail, return receipt requested, addressed to said Director at the aforesaid address, at least seven (7) days before my return to the practice of nursing in the State of New York.


I hereby make this application to the Board of Regents and request that it be granted.

SPECIFICATION OF PROFESSIONAL MISCONDUCT

Respondent is charged with committing unprofessional conduct in the profession of nursing, within the purview and meaning of New York Education Law section 6509(9), in specific violation of 8 NYCRR 29.1(b)(5), in that:

Respondent, at approximately 9:06 A.M. on or about May 21, 2018, while employed as a registered professional nurse at Buffalo General Medical Center, Buffalo, New York, withdrew one (1) vial of the controlled substance Fentanyl, containing 250 mcg for patient V.W. but used it for her own personal use.

TERMS OF PROBATION

SEVERINE MARIE WHITTIER

1. That respondent, during the period of probation, shall be in compliance with the standards of conduct prescribed by the law governing respondent's profession;
2. That respondent shall submit written notification to the New York State Education Department, addressed to the Director, Office of Professional Discipline, New York State Education Department, 1411 Broadway - Tenth Floor, New York, New York 10018-3496, of any employment and/or practice, respondent's residence, telephone number, or mailing address, and of any change in respondent's employment, practice, residence, telephone number, or mailing address within or without the State of New York;
3. That respondent shall, during the period of probation, remain free from substance abuse and shall be fit to practice her profession;
4. That respondent shall, within the first four (4) months of the probationary period, at respondent's expense, submit and successfully complete a plan of continuing education, consisting of coursework in ethics and documentation, to update the knowledge and skills of respondent, said plan to have the prior written approval of the New York State Education Department; and shall submit written proof of such successful completion within 30 days after the completion of the plan to the New York State Education Department, addressed to the Director, Office of Professional Discipline, as aforesaid;
5. That respondent shall submit written proof from the Division of Professional Licensing Services (DPLS), New York State Education Department (NYSED), that respondent has paid all registration fees due and owing to the NYSED and respondent shall cooperate with and submit whatever papers are requested by DPLS in regard to said registration fees, said proof from DPLS to be submitted by respondent to the NYSED, addressed to the Director, Office of Professional Discipline, as aforesaid, no later than the first three months of the period of probation;

6. That respondent shall submit written proof to the NYSED, addressed to the Director, Office of Professional Discipline, as aforesaid, that 1) respondent is currently registered with the NYSED, unless respondent submits written proof that respondent has advised DPLS, NYSED, that respondent is not engaging in the practice of respondent's profession in the State of New York and does not desire to register, and that 2) respondent has paid any fines which may have previously been imposed upon respondent by the Board of Regents, said proof of the above to be submitted no later than the first two months of the period of probation;
7. That respondent shall make quarterly visits to an employee of the Office of Professional Discipline, New York State Education Department, unless otherwise agreed to by said employee, for the purpose of said employee monitoring respondent's terms of probation to assure compliance therewith, and respondent shall cooperate with said employee, including the submission of information requested by said employee, regarding the aforesaid monitoring;
8. That upon receipt of evidence of noncompliance with or any other violation of any of the aforementioned terms of probation, the New York State Education Department may initiate a violation of probation proceeding and/or such other proceedings pursuant to the Education Law and/or Rules of the Board of Regents.





**CONSENT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
SEVERINE MARIE WHITTIER, RN, APRN-CRNA
AND
OHIO BOARD OF NURSING**

This Consent Agreement is entered into by and between **SEVERINE MARIE WHITTIER** (“**MS. WHITTIER**”), RN, APRN-CRNA, and the Ohio Board of Nursing (Board), the state agency charged with enforcing Chapter 4723. of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC), and all administrative rules promulgated thereunder.

For purposes of this Agreement, “Consent Agreement” shall be defined as this Agreement, and the following record attached hereto and incorporated herein:

- Notice of Opportunity for Hearing, dated September 17, 2020 (Notice).

This Consent Agreement contains the entire agreement between the parties, there being no other agreement of any kind, verbal or otherwise, which varies the terms of this Consent Agreement.

BASIS FOR ACTION

This Consent Agreement is entered into on the basis of the following stipulations, admissions, and understandings:

- A. The Board is empowered by Section 4723.28, ORC, to deny, permanently revoke, revoke, suspend, or place restrictions on any nursing license issued by the Board; reprimand or otherwise discipline a licensee; or impose a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or less per violation. Section 4723.28(B)(1), ORC, authorizes the Board to discipline a licensee for denial, revocation, suspension, or restriction of authority to engage in a licensed profession or practice a health care occupation, including nursing, for any reason other than a failure to renew, in Ohio or another state or jurisdiction.
- B. **MS. WHITTIER** is licensed to practice as a registered nurse and advanced practice registered nurse designated as a certified nurse anesthetist in the State of Ohio, RN-391340 and APRN-CRNA-18794. **MS. WHITTIER**’s licenses were initially issued in May 2013 and February 2016, respectively. **MS. WHITTIER**’s licenses to practice as a registered nurse and advanced practice registered nurse designated as a certified nurse anesthetist are

inactive as of October 31, 2019.

C. **MS. WHITTIER** knowingly and voluntarily admits to the factual and legal allegations set forth in the Notice.

D. On December 30, 2020, a Settlement Conference was held with **MS. WHITTIER** and her attorney. **MS. WHITTIER** stated:

1. On May 21, 2018, while working as a registered nurse at Buffalo General Medical Center, Buffalo, New York, she withdrew one (1) vial of Fentanyl containing 250mcg for a patient but used it for her own personal use. An Anesthesiologist recognized that the amount she withdrew was too much for the patient and confronted her about the transaction. She admitted that she diverted Fentanyl for self-administration and had a plan to harm herself that day. She was taken to the ER and subsequently admitted to detox for 9 days. Upon discharge, she went to the Parkdale Center for Professionals in Chesterton, Indiana, and began an 8-week inpatient program.
2. She diverted medication from her employer to deal with migraines and trouble sleeping. She did not self-administer the medication while she was working; rather, she took the medication home and self-administered it before going to bed.
3. She currently lives and works in Waco, Texas. She participates in the Texas Peer Assistance Program for Nurses (TPAPN). Her sobriety date is June 2, 2018. She began the TPAPN program in August 2018 and is expected to complete the program in August 2021. She attends two (2) to four (4) AA meetings per week, works a 12-step program, has a sponsor, has a home group, sees a counselor every other week, and she submits to daily call-ins and random drug testing. To date, she has provided fifty-five (55) negative drug screen tests and is in compliance with all of the TPAPN's program requirements. She has a strong support system that includes family, friends and other recovering professionals. She is grateful for the chance to gain back the trust of the public and those in her profession.
4. She entered into a Participant Work Agreement with the TPAPN in February 2020. She is approved by the TPAPN to handle narcotics. She is employed full time as a CRNA with Mid-Texas Anesthesia, Associates (Mid-Texas). She does not intend to return to the practice of nursing in Ohio.

E. Through her attorney, **MS. WHITTIER** submitted the following:

1. A copy of a letter from the Waco IOP Program Manager, Arbor Intensive Outpatient Program, verifying **MS. WHITTIER**'s successful completion of The Arbor Behavioral Healthcare's Intensive Outpatient Program in Waco, Texas, on November 5, 2018. The letter indicates that **MS. WHITTIER**'s discharge recommendations include: Continued individual therapy, 12-step participation, medication management with PCP, and The Arbor's Aftercare Meeting on

Wednesday nights, and that, as long as **MS. WHITTIER** follows the discharge recommendations, she is approved to return to work within the guidelines of her TPAPN monitoring.

2. A copy of a letter from the TPAPN dated September 24, 2019, verifying **MS. WHITTIER's** participation in the TPAPN program and her adherence to all of the program's requirements.
3. A copy of a letter from the TPAPN dated October 28, 2020, verifying that **MS. WHITTIER** is currently participating in the TPAPN program and is expected to complete the program on August 21, 2021. The letter indicates that she has provided fifty-five (55) negative drug screen tests, and that she is currently employed as a nurse and the TPAPN receives positive reports from her employer.
4. A copy of **MS. WHITTIER's** Participation Agreement, Case No. 50449, in the TPAPN program.
5. A copy of **MS. WHITTIER's** Work Agreement Addendum for Return to Anesthesia Practice and Participant Work Agreement, signed and dated by her employer on February 9, 2020.

AGREED CONDITIONS

Wherefore, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, and in lieu of any formal proceedings at this time, **MS. WHITTIER** knowingly and voluntarily agrees with the Board to the following:

PROBATIONARY PERIOD

MS. WHITTIER's licenses shall be suspended indefinitely. Such suspension shall be stayed subject to the following Probationary Terms and Restrictions for a minimum period of two (2) years.

PROBATIONARY TERMS AND RESTRICTIONS

MS. WHITTIER shall:

1. *Not work in a position that requires a license to practice as a nurse until she submits a written request to work as a nurse and obtains written approval from the Board or its designee. **MS. WHITTIER** must be in full compliance with this Consent Agreement prior to requesting to work as a nurse.*
2. Obey all federal, state, and local laws, and all laws and rules governing the practice of nursing in Ohio.

3. Appear in person for interviews with the Board's designated representative, as requested by the Board or its designee.
4. Submit documentation that she has complied with the terms and conditions imposed by the Consent Order of New York State Board of Nursing, May 20, 2020.
5. Submit proof of successful completion of the Texas Peer Assistance Program and that her Texas licenses are current, valid, and unrestricted.
6. Submit a request to the Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation (BCII) to conduct a criminal records check of **MS. WHITTIER**, including a check of Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) records, and shall request that BCII submit **MS. WHITTIER's** criminal records check to the Board. **MS. WHITTIER's** completed criminal records check, including the FBI check, must be received by the Board prior to **MS. WHITTIER requesting to work as a nurse.**

Evaluations

7. **Upon the request of the Board or its designee and within sixty (60) days of that request, at MS. WHITTIER's expense, obtain a substance use disorder evaluation by a substance use disorder professional approved by the Board or its designee and, prior to the evaluation, provide the substance use disorder professional with a copy of this Consent Agreement. MS. WHITTIER shall execute releases to permit the substance use disorder professional to obtain any information deemed appropriate and necessary for the evaluation. The substance use disorder professional shall submit a written opinion to the Board that includes diagnoses, recommendations for treatment and monitoring, any additional restrictions that should be placed on MS. WHITTIER's licenses, and a statement as to whether MS. WHITTIER is capable of practicing nursing according to acceptable and prevailing standards of safe nursing care.**
8. **If a substance use disorder evaluation is requested, provide the Board with satisfactory documentation of compliance with all aspects of the treatment plan developed by the substance use disorder professional described above until released. Further, MS. WHITTIER agrees that the Board may utilize the professional's recommendations and conclusions from the evaluation as a basis for additional terms and restrictions on MS. WHITTIER's licenses and that the terms and restrictions shall be incorporated in an addendum to this Consent Agreement.**

Monitoring

9. Abstain completely from personal use or possession of drugs, except those prescribed, administered, or dispensed to her by another so authorized by law who has full knowledge of **MS. WHITTIER's** history. **MS. WHITTIER** shall self-administer prescribed drugs only in the manner prescribed.
10. Abstain completely from the use of alcohol or any products containing alcohol.

11. **For a minimum, continuous period of ninety (90) days immediately prior to requesting to work as a nurse and continuing throughout the probationary period**, submit, at **MS. WHITTIER's** expense and on the day selected, blood, breath, hair or urine specimens for drug and/or alcohol analysis at a collection site specified by the Board at such times as the Board may request. Upon and after **MS. WHITTIER's** initiation of drug screening, refusal to submit such specimen, or failure to submit such specimen on the day she is selected, or in such a manner as the Board may request, shall constitute a violation of a restriction placed on a license for purposes of Section 4723.28(B), ORC. This screening shall require a daily call-in process. The specimens submitted by **MS. WHITTIER** shall be negative, except for substances prescribed, administered, or dispensed to her by another so authorized by law who has received a complete copy of this Consent Agreement prior to prescribing for **MS. WHITTIER**.

a. *Prior* to initiating drug screening:

- i. Provide a copy of this Consent Agreement to all treating practitioners;
- ii. Provide to the Board a list of all treating practitioners, including addresses and telephone numbers; and
- iii. Cause all treating practitioners to complete a medication prescription report for any and all substances prescribed, administered, or dispensed to **MS. WHITTIER**, *and* submit the report directly to the Board.

b. *After* initiating drug screening, be under a *continuing duty* to:

- i. Provide a copy of this Consent Agreement, prior to initiating treatment, to additional treating practitioners;
- ii. Update the list of treating practitioners with the Board within forty-eight (48) hours of being treated by another practitioner;
- iii. Notify the Board of any and all medication(s) or prescription(s) received within twenty-four (24) hours of release from hospitalization or medical treatment; and
- iv. Cause all treating practitioners to complete a medication prescription report for any and all substances prescribed, administered, or dispensed to **MS. WHITTIER** *and* submit the report directly to the Board.

12. **For a minimum, continuous period of ninety (90) days immediately prior to requesting to work as a nurse and continuing throughout the probationary period**, attend a minimum of one (1) meeting per week of a support or peer group meeting approved in advance by the Board, or a Twelve Step program, and provide satisfactory documentation of such attendance to the Board every six (6) months.

Employment Conditions

13. **Upon the request of the Board or its designee, complete and submit satisfactory documentation of completion of a nurse refresher course or an extensive orientation approved in advance by the Board or its designee.**
14. Notify the Board, in writing, **prior to accepting employment as a nurse**, each time and with every employer. Any period during which **MS. WHITTIER** does not work in a position within the State of Ohio for which a license to practice nursing is required **shall not count** toward fulfilling the probationary period imposed by this Consent Agreement.
15. Have a continuing duty to provide a copy of this Consent Agreement to any new employer(s) **prior to accepting employment as a nurse.**
16. Have employer(s), if working in a position where a license to practice nursing is required, submit written reports regarding job performance **on a quarterly basis beginning within thirty (30) days of working in a position as a nurse.**
17. Have employer(s) send documentation to the Board, along with the first employer report, of receipt of a copy of this Consent Agreement, including the date this Consent Agreement was received.

Reporting Requirements for Probationary Period

18. Report to the Board, in writing, any violation of this Consent Agreement within thirty (30) days of the occurrence of the violation.
19. Sign release of information forms allowing health professionals and other organizations to submit the requested documentation directly to the Board.
20. Submit any and all information that the Board may request regarding **MS. WHITTIER's** ability to practice nursing according to acceptable and prevailing standards of safe nursing care.
21. Not submit or cause to be submitted any false, misleading, or deceptive statements, information, or documentation to the Board or to employers or potential employers.
22. Submit the reports and documentation required by this Consent Agreement on forms specified by the Board. All reporting and communications required by this Consent Agreement shall be sent by email to: monitoring@nursing.ohio.gov or by mail to:

23. Verify that the reports and documentation required by this Consent Agreement are received in the Board office.
24. Inform the Board **within five (5) business days**, in writing, of any change in employment status or of any change in residential or home address or telephone number.

LICENSE RESTRICTIONS

In addition to Probationary Terms and Restrictions, MS. WHITTIER's licenses are subject to the following License Restrictions:

Temporary Practice Restrictions

Unless otherwise approved in advance, in writing, by the Board or its designee, MS. WHITTIER shall not practice nursing as a registered nurse or an advanced practice registered nurse designated as a certified nurse anesthetist (1) in a patient's residence; (2) for staffing agencies or pools; (3) for an individual or group of individuals who directly engage MS. WHITTIER to provide nursing services for fees, compensation, or other consideration or who engage MS. WHITTIER as a volunteer; or (4) as an independent contractor or for *locum tenens* assignments.

Unless otherwise approved in advance, in writing, by the Board or its designee, MS. WHITTIER shall not function in a position or employment where the job duties or requirements involve management of nursing and nursing responsibilities, or supervising and evaluating nursing practice. Such positions include, but are not limited to, the following: Director of Nursing, Assistant Director of Nursing, Nurse Manager, Vice President of Nursing.

FAILURE TO COMPLY

MS. WHITTIER agrees that her licenses to practice nursing as a registered nurse and advanced practice registered nurse designated as a certified nurse anesthetist will be automatically suspended if it appears to the Board that MS. WHITTIER has violated or breached any terms or conditions of this Consent Agreement. Following the automatic suspension, the Board shall notify MS. WHITTIER via certified mail of the specific nature of the charges and automatic suspension of MS. WHITTIER's licenses. MS. WHITTIER may request a hearing regarding the charges.

The above described terms and conditions shall constitute "restrictions placed on a license" for purposes of Section 4723.28(B), ORC. If, in the discretion of the Board, MS. WHITTIER appears to have violated or breached any terms or restrictions of this Consent Agreement, the Board reserves the right to institute formal disciplinary proceedings for any and all possible violations or breaches, including, but not limited to, alleged violations of the laws of Ohio occurring before the effective date of this Consent Agreement.

DURATION/MODIFICATION OF TERMS

The terms and restrictions of this Consent Agreement may be modified or terminated, in writing, at any time upon the agreement of both **MS. WHITTIER** and the Board.

The Board may only alter the probationary period imposed by this Consent Agreement if: (1) the Board determines that **MS. WHITTIER** has complied with all aspects of this Consent Agreement; and (2) the Board determines that **MS. WHITTIER** is able to practice nursing according to acceptable and prevailing standards of safe nursing care without Board monitoring, based upon an interview with **MS. WHITTIER** and review of the reports as required herein.

As indicated above under Employment Conditions, any period during which **MS. WHITTIER** does not work in a position within the State of Ohio for which a license to practice nursing is required shall not count toward fulfilling the probationary period imposed by this Consent Agreement.

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS/LIABILITY RELEASE

MS. WHITTIER acknowledges that she has had an opportunity to ask questions concerning the terms of this Consent Agreement and that all questions asked have been answered in a satisfactory manner.

MS. WHITTIER waives all of her rights under Chapter 119, ORC, as they relate to matters that are the subject of this Consent Agreement.

MS. WHITTIER acknowledges that her license status listed on the Board's web-based verification site will not be accessible to the general public, including potential employers, until **MS. WHITTIER** is notified that written approval has been given by the Board or its designee that **MS. WHITTIER** is authorized to work in a position that requires a license to practice as a nurse. Any inquiries regarding **MS. WHITTIER's** status prior to the time **MS. WHITTIER** is authorized to work as a nurse will be addressed by telephone or in person by Board staff.

MS. WHITTIER waives any and all claims or causes of action she may have against the Board, and its members, officers, employees and/or agents arising out of matters, which are the subject of this Consent Agreement.

This Consent Agreement shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43, ORC. The information contained herein shall be reported to data banks and governmental bodies.


This Consent Agreement is not an adjudication order as discussed in Chapter 119, ORC. Any action initiated by the Board based on alleged violations of this Consent Agreement shall comply with the Administrative Procedures Act, Chapter 119, ORC.



In accordance with Chapter 119, Ohio Revised Code (ORC), you are hereby notified that the Ohio Board of Nursing (Board) proposes under authority of Section 4723.28, ORC, to deny or permanently deny reinstatement of your licenses to practice as a registered nurse and as an advanced practice registered nurse designated as a certified registered nurse anesthetist; revoke, permanently revoke, suspend or place restrictions on your licenses to practice as a registered nurse and as an advanced practice registered nurse designated as a certified registered nurse anesthetist; reprimand or otherwise discipline you; or impose a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per violation for the following reasons:

1. Effective on or about May 20, 2020, the New York State Board of Nursing issued a Consent Order (New York 2020 Order) indefinitely suspending your New York registered professional nurse license. *A certified copy of the New York 2020 Order is attached hereto and incorporated herein.*

Section 4723.28(B)(1), ORC, authorizes the Board to discipline a licensee for denial, revocation, suspension, or restriction of authority to engage in a licensed profession or practice a health care occupation, including nursing, for any reason other than a failure to renew, in Ohio or another state or jurisdiction.


