ORDER OF THE BOARD

On this day the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Board, considered the matter of SIVAN PARIENTA, Registered Nurse License Number 860255, hereinafter referred to as Respondent.

This action was taken in accordance with Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code.

Respondent waived notice and hearing and agreed to the entry of this Order.

The Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent's license to practice as a professional nurse in the State of Texas is in current status.
2. Respondent waived notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Order.
3. Respondent received an Associate Degree in Nursing from El Centro College, Dallas, Texas, on May 15, 2014. Respondent was licensed to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas on July 8, 2014.
4. Respondent's nursing employment history includes:

5. On or about March 15, 2021, the Board provided notice to Respondent that an investigation was being initiated into alleged violations of the Nursing Practice Act and/or the Board's Rules and Regulations Relating to Nurse Education, Licensure, and Practice, as follows:
 - On multiple occasions in 2020, while employed as a Registered Nurse with Lemmon Avenue Plastic Surgery Center, Dallas, Texas, Respondent lacked fitness to practice nursing in that she was observed arriving to work under the influence of alcohol that she ingested prior to coming into her shift.
 - On or about April 1, 2020, through April 30, 2020, while employed as a Registered Nurse with Lemmon Avenue Plastic Surgery Center, Dallas, Texas, Respondent violated the professional boundaries of the nurse/client relationship by inappropriately engaging in an intimate relationship with a patient.
 - On or about April 1, 2020, through April 30, 2020, while employed as a Registered Nurse with Lemmon Avenue Plastic Surgery Center, Dallas, Texas, Respondent exceeded her scope of practice by administering injectable fillers such as Botox, Kybella, Dysport, Juvederm, Restylane, and Sculptra to patients, in their homes, without physician orders or medical supervision. Additionally, Respondent violated CDC guidelines regarding elective procedures during quarantine due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
6. On or about March 31, 2021, the Board provided notice to Respondent that an investigation was being initiated into alleged violations of the Nursing Practice Act and/or the Board's Rules and Regulations Relating to Nurse Education, Licensure, and Practice, as follows:
 - On multiple occasions between December 2020 and March 18, 2021, while contracted as a Registered Nurse with Lemmon Avenue Plastic Surgery, Dallas, Texas, through her company Lips By Sivan, LLC, Respondent misappropriated injectable filler product, such as Botox, Kybella, Dysport, Juvederm, Restylane and Sculptra, from the facility. More specifically, Respondent took expired injectable filler product from her personal home inventory to Lemmon Avenue Plastic Surgery and transferred the expired product to the facility's new blank syringes. Respondent then discarded the expired filler packaging in the facility's shred bin,

including product label stickers. Subsequently, Respondent injected her assigned patients with the syringes that contained the expired filler product. Respondent proceeded to retrieve a box of the same or similar unexpired injectable filler product from the facility's supply cabinet, removed extra labels from the packages and affixed them to her assigned patients' chart/encounter forms to falsely reflect treatments were completed using the facility's untampered filler product. Further, Respondent took the unused and unexpired injectable filler product belonging to the facility to her home to keep in her personal inventory. In addition, Respondent used the filler product she misappropriated from the facility on various individuals, in their homes, without a physician's order or medical supervision.

7. On September 27, 2023, the Board received a notarized statement from Respondent voluntarily surrendering the right to practice nursing in Texas. A copy of Respondent's statement, dated September 27, 2023, is attached and incorporated herein by reference as part of this Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451 - 301.555, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
3. The evidence received is sufficient to prove violation(s) of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.11 (1)(A),(1)(B),(1)(C),(1)(D),(1)(J),(1)(O),(1)(P)&(3)(A) and 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12 (1)(A),(1)(B),(1)(C),(3),(4),(6)(A),(6)(D),(6)(G),(6)(I),(8),(10)(B),(10)(E)&(11)(B).
4. The evidence received is sufficient cause pursuant to Section 301.452(b)(10) &(13)(effective through 8/31/2021), Texas Occupations Code, to take disciplinary action against Registered Nurse License Number 860255, heretofore issued to SIVAN PARIENTA, including revocation of Respondent's license(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas.
5. Under Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code, the Board has the authority to accept the voluntary surrender of a license.
6. Under Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, as amended, the Board may impose conditions for reinstatement of licensure.
7. Any subsequent reinstatement of this license will be controlled by Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §213.26-.29, and any amendments thereof in effect at the time of the reinstatement.


TERMS OF ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of Registered Nurse License Number 860255 is accepted by the Texas Board of Nursing. In connection with this acceptance, the Board imposes the following conditions:

1. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT practice professional/registered nursing, use the title "registered nurse" or the abbreviation "RN" or wear any insignia identifying herself/himself as a registered nurse or use any designation which, directly or indirectly, would lead any person to believe that RESPONDENT is a registered nurse during the period in which the license is surrendered.
2. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT petition for reinstatement of licensure until at least one (1) year has elapsed from the date of this Order.
3. Upon petitioning for reinstatement, RESPONDENT SHALL satisfy all then existing requirements for relicensure.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice nursing in the State of Texas.


Before me, the undersigned notary, personally appeared, Sivan Parienta, who, after being duly sworn and cautioned, stated as follows:


3. I hereby voluntarily surrender my nursing license to the TBN as I do not desire to be licensed.”

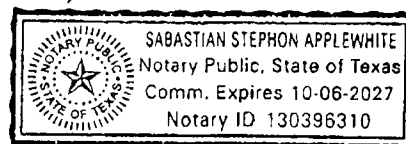
