C. Incident Reporting: While under the remaining terms of this Order, RESPONDENT SHALL CAUSE each employer to immediately submit all incident, counseling, variance, unusual occurrence, and medication or other error reports involving RESPONDENT, as

well as documentation of any internal investigations regarding action by RESPONDENT, to the

attention of Monitoring at the Board's office.

D. Nursing Performance Evaluations: While under the remaining terms of this

Order, RESPONDENT SHALL CAUSE each employer to submit, on forms provided to the

RESPONDENT by the Board, periodic reports as to RESPONDENT's capability to practice

nursing. These reports shall be completed by the employer and submitted to the office of the Board

at the end of each three (3) month quarterly period for the remaining period of the July 23, 2020,

Order.

All other terms and conditions of the July 23, 2020, Agreed Order remain

unchanged, and Petitioner is responsible for complying with those terms as written.
